3 **WHEREAS**, Joaquin “Danny” Siguenza Santos, Jr., graduated from
4 George Washington High School, and then received a Bachelor’s Degree from
5 the University of Dayton and a Master’s Degree from Pepperdine University;
6 and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Santos is also a graduate of the Communication Officer
8 Electronic Warfare Analyst School, and the Joint Armed Forces Staff College;
9 and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Santos dedicated himself to the U.S. Marine Corps for
11 twenty-six (26) years, ultimately retiring in 1986 as a U.S. Marine Corps
12 Colonel; and

13 **WHEREAS**, upon retirement, Mr. Santos returned to Guam to
14 eventually become the General Manager of the Guam Telephone Authority,
15 and during that time he moved GTA from analog to digital technology; and

16 **WHEREAS**, following his accomplishment at GTA, Mr. Santos assumed
17 the position of General Manager of Sprint Guam, from 1992 until its closing in
18 1997; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in 2001, Mr. Santos resumed his service with the
20 government of Guam as the Assistant General Manager of Operations for the
21 Guam Waterworks Authority; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Santos was selected by the Consolidated Commission
2 on Utilities as the Assistant General Manager of Consolidated Administration
3 for both the Guam Waterworks Authority and the Guam Power Authority in
4 2005; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Santos is the recipient of the Legion of Merit,
6 Humanitarian Resolution from the Province of Zambales, Republic of the
7 Philippines; he was inducted into the President’s Club, Sprint International;
8 and he was recognized at the 1st Annual ESGR Awards Gala with the coveted
9 Lifetime Achievement Award; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Santos is an active member of the Third Marine
11 Division Association, the Nino Perdido Parish Council, and he serves as the
12 Vice-Chairman of ESGR; and


13 **WHEREAS**, this amount of dedication and loyalty to sectors of the

19 to the U.S. Marine Corps and Guam; and be it further


20 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary
