**Relative to commending Sergeant Joseph S. Carbullido of the  
Guam Police Department for his notable act of bravery in saving  
a person's life on May 24, 2009.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN  
GUÅHAN:**

1       **WHEREAS,** Joseph S. Carbullido was born in 1961 in Guam to Francisco  
2 Muna Carbullido and Julianna Santiago Carbullido of Agat; and

3       **WHEREAS,** Joseph S. Carbullido is married to Jennifer Jerusalem, together  
4 they have four wonderful children, Collin Carbullido, Joleen Carbullido, John  
5 Palanca, and Katrina Palanca, and they reside in Dededo; and

6       **WHEREAS,** Joseph S. Carbullido joined the Guam Police Department in  
7 December 1988, he earned his rank of Police Sergeant in 2004, and he has proudly  
8 served in the police force for more than twenty-one years; and

9       **WHEREAS,** Sergeant Carbullido has received numerous awards, certificates  
10 and commendations for his outstanding performance, including several Guam Police

1 Distinguished Service Medals, the Employee of the Year for Public Safety, and the  
2 Supervisor of the Year for Public Safety; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Carbullido is a graduate of the University of Guam  
4 earning a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice and Public Administration in  
5 2006, and a Master's degree in Public Administration and Supervision in 2008; and

6 **WHEREAS**, on the night of May 24, 2009, tragedy fell upon Guam's roads  
7 affecting several families, Sergeant Carbullido, while off duty, witnessed a two-car  
8 collision at the Route 16 Overpass; and

9 **WHEREAS**, upon witnessing this collision, Sergeant Carbullido immediately  
10 stopped his vehicle, ran to one of the vehicles that was now afire and discovered an  
11 unconscious male; and

12 **WHEREAS**, by instinct and conditioned throughout his career as a police  
13 officer, Sergeant Carbullido pulled the person out of the inferno, without regard of his  
14 own safety to save the life of a fellow citizen; now, therefore, be it

15 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on  
16 behalf of the people of Guam, commend and honor Police Sergeant Joseph S.  
17 Carbullido for his notable act of bravery in saving a person's life on the night of May  
18 24, 2009; and be it further

19 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify and the Secretary of the Legislature  
20 attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to
