- 1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***  
3 **WHEREAS,** Daniel Finoña Pereda was born in Guam on August 31,  
4 1960, to +Juan Cruz Pereda and +Rosa Finoña Pereda; and

1           **WHEREAS,**       Captain Daniel F. Pereda is married to Guadalupe  
2 Cruz Pereda, currently residing in the village of Chalan Pago and as proud  
3 parents have raised four wonderful children, Deanna, Naomi, Daniel and  
4 Josephine; and

5           **WHEREAS,**       he graduated from Guam Community College  
6 Vocational High School Division in 1979, and subsequently enlisted with  
7 United States Army in the field of Ninety-five (95) Charlie Correctional  
8 Specialist from 1979 to 1982; and

9           **WHEREAS,**       he first gained employment with the Department of  
10 Corrections on July 5, 1983 as Corrections Officer I. After fourteen (14) years  
11 as a Corrections Officer I, he was promoted to Corrections Officer Supervisor I  
12 as a Sergeant on March 21, 1997 and seven (7) years later was again promoted  
13 to Corrections Officer Supervisor II as Lieutenant on February 7, 2004; and

14           **WHEREAS,**       over the years, Captain Pereda has served with  
15 distinction becoming one of the most well known and loved corrections  
16 officer within the Department of Corrections, exemplifying characteristics  
17 unlike any other; and

18           **WHEREAS,**       Captain Pereda is notable for his contributions such as  
19 being Vice Chairperson and member of the Adjustment and Classification  
20 Committee; a member of the Special Operations Response Team (SORT); and  
21 currently is the Chairperson for the Disciplinary Hearing Board; and

22           **WHEREAS,**       Captain Daniel F. Pereda has served the island of  
23 Guam in the area of Corrections and Rehabilitation for twenty-six (26) years,  
24 thus demonstrating his commitment to the well-being of the people of Guam

1 and the rehabilitation of inmates at the Department of Corrections; now,  
2 therefore, be it

3       **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina' Trenta Na*  
4 *Lihsaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihsaturan Guåhan* and the  
5 people of Guam, commend and congratulate Captain Daniel Finoña Pereda
