**Relative to recognizing Antonia Villagomez, one of Guam's Working Class Heroes, for her hard work and dedication, not just to her job, but to all the people of Guam; and to extending *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os ma'åse'* to Ms. Antonia Villagomez for her outstanding citizenship and accomplishments.**

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Guam functions and succeeds as a result of the hard work of all  
4 our working class heroes that serve our island everyday as workers, as parents, as  
5 children, as friends, and as active citizens in our democracy; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Guam's working class heroes have long been the forgotten  
7 backbone of our island, and they should be recognized for their commitment and  
8 loyalty in serving the community; and

9 **WHEREAS,** there would be no tourism industry without hotel workers, no  
10 schools without education professionals, no healthcare without nurses, no stores  
11 without clerks, no phones without lines people, no clean streets without solid waste  
12 professionals, no safe beaches and pools without lifeguards and park rangers, no  
13 safety and protection without police officers and firefighters, no restaurants without  
14 servers or cooks, no balanced books without accountants, no clean water without  
15 water workers, no clean and maintained schools and buildings without custodians and

1 maintenance workers, and no children at school without bus drivers. Guam thrives  
2 thanks to our working class heroes; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Antonia Villagomez worked as a Cooking Assistant for  
4 Bishop Baumgartner Memorial School for four (4) years preparing and cooking  
5 breakfast and lunch meals for our children ensuring they are well fed with the proper  
6 nutritious food; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Antonia Villagomez has been serving our children for  
8 twenty-one (21) years in Guam's public schools, consisting of C.L. Taitano  
9 Elementary School, Chalan Pago-Ordot Elementary School, and currently at H.B.  
10 Price Elementary School, as a Cooking Assistant as well as preparing and cooking  
11 breakfast and lunch meals; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Antonia Villagomez commits her spare time being a member  
13 of the Guam Sunshine Lion's Club for over a year now helping the community with  
14 various projects, making a positive impact for our island; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Antonia Villagomez has been working hard in her job to  
16 financially support six (6) children as a single mother and still making the time to  
17 nurture and raise them to be good citizens; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Antonia Villagomez's dedication and commitment to serving  
19 meals for our children at school for over twenty (20) years in our island while having  
20 the ability to be a supportive, single mother for her children shows a lot of  
21 determination and strength; now, therefore, be it

22 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan*  
23 *Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam,  
24 recognize Antonia Villagomez, one of Guam's working class heroes, for her hard  
25 work and dedication, not just to her job, but to all the people of Guam; and does  
26 extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os ma'åse'* to Ms. Antonia Villagomez for her  
27 outstanding citizenship and accomplishments; and be it further
