



**I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN**

**Relative to recognizing and congratulating The United States Army Retirees Association of Guam as it celebrates its 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and for its selfless efforts in serving and supporting U.S. Army Veterans and their families on Guam.**

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:**

2 **Whereas**, the U.S. Army Retirees Association of Guam (USARAG) was formed  
3 by a few dedicated Army retirees who saw the need to raise awareness of issues  
4 confronting veterans; and,

5 **Whereas**, the USARAG was formally organized on December 12, 1979 with the  
6 mission to foster and support programs and activities which raise awareness of issues  
7 confronting Veterans and promote the well being of Army Retirees and their families;  
8 and,

9 **Whereas**, the USARAG has shown dedication and commitment towards  
10 improving our community through projects and programs such as the University of  
11 Guam ROTC program scholarship, Na La Bonita Guahan - Cleanup of WWII Memorial  
12 Sites, and the St. Dominic's Christmas Caroling and Donation Drive; and,

1           **Whereas**, the USARAG has organized annual membership drives and outreach  
2 programs to raise awareness amongst the Army Retiree community of local and federal  
3 resources and benefits available to Army Retirees; and

4           **Whereas**, numerous Army Retirees and their families have benefited through the  
5 services and support provided by the USARAG; now, therefore, be it

6           **Resolved**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the  
7 people of Guam, recognize and congratulate the United States Army Retirees  
8 Association of Guam and the many volunteers and sponsors on the Association's 30<sup>th</sup>  
9 Anniversary and for the selfless and invaluable service they provide to the Army  
10 Retirees of Guam and to the community at large; and, be it further

11           **Resolved**, that the Speaker certify and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to,  
12 the adoption hereof and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Mr.  
13 Anthony J.M. Guzman, President of the United States Army Retirees Association of
