RELATIVE TO EXTENDING A SPECIAL CONGRATULATIONS TO MR. CONG LIN WU ON THE NOTABLE OCCASION OF BEING RECOGNIZED AS ONE OF THE OUTSTANDING LEADERS OF THE NEW AND MODERN OVERSEAS CHINESE COMMUNITY, HAVING BEEN A DISTINGUISHED RECIPIENT OF THE "2009 CHINA TOP 10 FINANCIAL AND INTELLEAGENT PERSONS" AWARD; AND FURTHER EXTENDING A DANGKOLO' NA SI YU'OS MA'ASE' FOR HIS EXCEPTIONAL SERVICE AND CONTRIBUTION TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I

3 WHEREAS, in 1975 Mr. Cong Lin Wu received a Bachelor of Arts in
4 English, Foreign Language Department, Fudan University; from 1976 to
5 1986 worked with Chinese-Polish Shipping Company; and from 1987 to
6 1991 worked with China Merchant's Company, Guam; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Wu is a person of exceptional ability and vision;
8 successfully started an international trade company in 1991; President of
9 JJQ International Trading Company, Ltd, Guam, and former President of
10 the Guam Chinese Association; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in addition to his accomplishments in the business
2 realm, he also dedicated his time to actively help build stronger relations
3 between China, the country of his birth and Guam, the place he calls home;
4 and

5 **WHEREAS**, under Mr. Wu’s leadership as President of the Guam
6 Chinese Association, the organization received numerous Chinese Leaders
7 and dignitaries such as Consul Generals, Ambassadors, Sailors from the
8 Chinese Naval Fleet, Representatives and leaders from CAIFC who visited
9 Guam; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Wu worked with the Chinese Chamber of
11 Commerce of Guam, the U.S. Coast Guard, the Chinese Consulate and the
12 Guam Chinese Association in providing assistance, support and spiritual
13 comfort to those affected by numerous disasters to include the tragically
14 sunken ship “Haitong 7”, and the Sichuan earthquake which struck in May
15 2008 which received \$120,000.00 from the GCA; and

16 **WHEREAS**, as President of the Guam Chinese Association, Mr. Wu
17 also organized numerous variety shows and cultural performances to
18 promote the beauty of the Chinese culture and to help build long-lasting
19 friendships between the Chinese and the people of Guam; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Wu has kind-heartedly contributed to Guam’s
21 education, sports associations, cultural groups, and the disabled and
22 elderly; now, therefore, be it

1 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
2 does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam extend a special
3 congratulations to Mr. Cong Lin Wu on the notable occasion of being
4 recognized as one of the outstanding leaders of the new and modern
5 overseas Chinese community, having been a distinguished recipient of the
6 “2009 China Top 10 Financial and Intelligent Persons” Award; and further
7 extending a Dangkolo’ Na Si Yu’os Ma’ase’ for his exceptional service and
8 contribution to the people of Guam; and be it further
