



Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority Police, and the Federal Law Enforcement Officers for protecting our island.

BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA' TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, National Police Week will be celebrated nationwide from May 9 to 15, 2010 as a tribute to the men and women of law enforcement who protect our communities; and

WHEREAS, the brave personnel of the Guam Police Department, Port Authority of Guam Police Law Enforcement, and the A.B. Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority Police, and the Federal Law Enforcement Officers enforce the laws of our island every day, placing their lives at risk to defend our citizens; and

WHEREAS, with the mounting number of crimes in our community, our police officers and law enforcement personnel serve numerous increased hours sacrificing their time for the welfare of others; and

WHEREAS, these courageous men and women work with the civilian personnel who perform essential functions in support of the uniformed officers; and

WHEREAS, many of Guam’s police, law enforcement personnel, and peace officers, have died in the line of duty, the ultimate act of selflessness that will be remembered this week; and

WHEREAS, the men and women of law enforcement, including those who are retired, deserve public recognition for their unparalleled service to the people of Guam; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that *I Mina' Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the men and women of the Guam Police Department, Port Authority of Guam Police Law Enforcement, and the A.B. Won Pat Guam International Airport
