

Relative to commending Elvira Ayson Dorian for her twenty-five year service to the people of Guam, and to extending Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase' for her dedication to healing the community.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES *I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

**WHEREAS**, education is a lifelong process that is essential to the lives of everyone in the community; and

**WHEREAS**, on Guam, dedicated teachers tirelessly serve their students for a cause greater than themselves; and

**WHEREAS**, in June 1979, Elvira Ayson Dorian came to Guam to serve its people as an educator; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1985, Mrs. Dorian became an active faculty member at Santa Barbara Catholic School; and

**WHEREAS**, four years later, Mrs. Dorian joined the D.L. Perez Elementary School family, and has remained with the school for twenty-one

years; and

**WHEREAS**, she was a member of the Manila Public School Teachers Association; and

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Dorian also serves as a teacher of the Our Lady of Lourdes CCD program, and a member of the parish's Saturday night choir; and

**WHEREAS**, throughout her career, she has touched and inspired the lives of many school children and colleagues during her career; and

**WHEREAS**, after twenty-five years of educating the island's people, Mrs. Dorian will retire; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby commend Elvira Ayson Dorian for her twenty-five years of service to the people of Guam; and be it further

**RESOVLED**, that the Legislature extends Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase' for her dedication to educating the community; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules certify and the Secretary of the Legislature attest the adoption hereof and that copies of the same be transmitted to her family and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahaen Guahan*.
