



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Mr. Jay Shedd was born on September 10, 1960 to Ralph and Joan Shedd and is among three (3) children: one (1) brother– Dan; a sister – Ronna Anderson; and

WHEREAS, Jay is a 1978 graduate of Pacifica High School in Garden Grove, California; he attended California State University Long Beach in 1983 majoring in Chemistry, achieved his Liberal Studies Degree in 2007 while attending Arizona State University; and furthered his education in Network Operations Management School at Motorola University, Shawburg, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Jay is married to Sheila Cecile Baker are blessed with two (2) sons – Hayden Daniel (8) and Shane Austin (4.5), and two (2) daughters, Erica Beatrice (17) and Aiyana Camille; and

WHEREAS, Jay and Sheila are doubly blessed with the newest addition of their grandson, Wyatt, born September 19, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Shedd was employed with Motorola Communications and Electronics as a radio Communications representation from 1983 – 1985, and Zone Sales Manager, 1885 – 1989 in San Diego, California; he rose through the ranks of Motorola Communications and Electronics as the Regional Sales Manager from 1989 - 1991 in Glen Rock, New Jersey and Los Angeles, California; its Territory Business Manager (1991 – 1993) and Digital Dispatch Sales Manager (1993 – 1994) in Irvine, California; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Shedd career brought him to Guam as the Senior Vice President/General Manager/Corporate Officer with Guam Cell Communications, Inc. in 1994 – 2003 and served as a Consultant for Guamcell Communications. Jay's most current position is President and Chief Executive Officer of DOCOMO PACIFIC effectuated in May 2008. He performed duties and Chief Operating Officer and Partner for RevoTech LLC in Tempe, Arizona from 2001 – 2007, provided consultant work for Altnet Systems, Inc., Washington (2004 - 2005); and

WHEREAS, Jay was nominated and accepted into "Who's Who for International Executives, nominated by Guam Business News Magazine for Guam Business Person of the Year from 2000 – 2002, and in 1999 nominated as a Board Member for the Guam Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Shedd continues his active involvement in the Guam Chapter of American Red Cross, Board Chair of the Rotary Club of Guam, member of the Guam Chamber of Commerce Armed

Forces Committee and the Andersen Air Force Advisory Committee;

WHEREAS, in his personal and professional life, Jay assiduously stresses integrity and respect for others and has served as a source of inspiration to their colleagues, friends, and family, to whom they always encourage spiritual, personal, and professional growth; and, now therefore, be it
