**RELATIVE TO COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING
MS. MARY JANE VILORIA SEBASTIAN ON HER
RETIREMENT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY
AFFAIRS AND TO EXPRESSING OUR SINCERCE
GRATITUDE FOR HER TWENTY EIGHT (28) YEARS OF
PUBLIC SERVICE AND DEDICATION TO THE PEOPLE OF
GUAM.**

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I
2 MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, on December 1, 1948, Ms. Mary Jane V. Sebastian was born
4 to Vicente and Matilde Manibusan Viloría and raised by both her parents in
5 the village of Barrigada; and

6 WHEREAS, Ms. Mary Jane V. Sebastian, one of four children, is the
7 sister to Ms. Cristina S. Crisostomo, Mr. Rufo V. Sebastian, Ms. Annalynn S.
8 McDermott, and Ms. Carol V. Sebastian; and

9 WHEREAS, Ms. Sebastian, attended school at Carbullido Elementary
10 School, San Vicente Catholic School, John F. Kennedy High School, and

1 received her high school diploma at George Washington High School in 1967.
2 She attended the University of Guam and the International Business College;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, in April 1982 she became the first civilian employee for the
5 Department of Military Affairs on Guam holding the position as an
6 Administrative Staff Officer, Accountant. Prior to 1982, she held office at the
7 U.S. Naval Ship Repair Facility as a Supply Clerk and Accounts Maintenance
8 Clerk from September 1968 to December 1973. From December 1973 to
9 September 1974, she was a Supply Clerk at the Anderson Air Force Base Civil
10 Engineering Squadron; and

11 WHEREAS, she was the Central Base Fund Office Manager for 43 CSG
12 Special Services Division at Anderson Air Force Base from September 1974 to
13 May 1978 and is currently the Accountant to the Administrative Services
14 Officer at the Department of Military Affairs; and

15 WHEREAS, she was the recipient for a number of recognizable awards;
16 in 1990 she received a Certificate of Commendation from Edward G. Perez, a
17 Certificate of Commendation in 1996 from Benny M. Paulino, and was
18 declared Woman of the Year in 1992. In 1997, two awards were given in
19 recognition of her work and contributions to the passengers and families of
20 Korean Airlines flight 801 and Typhoon Paka. In 1999, she was recognized as
21 the Supervisor of the Year and received the Silent Ones Award. One of her
22 most recognized achievement was in 1998 when she was awarded the
23 Governor's Award of Excellence; and

24 WHEREAS, Ms. Sebastian worked with several recognizable adjutant

1 generals in her career; Brigadier General Robert H. Neitz, Major General
2 Frank C. Torres Jr., Brigadier General Simon C. Krevitsky, Brigadier General
3 Edward G. Perez, Brigadier General Edward R. Duenas, Colonel Ramon Q.
4 Sudo, Major General Benny M. Paulino, Brigadier General Robert M. Cockey,
5 Brigadier General Jerry M. Rivera, and Major General Donald J. Goldhorn;

6 WHEREAS, throughout the past twenty eight (28) years, through
7 dedication and commitment to public service, Ms. Sebastian has positively
8 impacted and contributed to the efficiency of the Department of Military
9 Affairs operations; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Sebastian has provided our island community a
11 valuable service of devoting her professional life to serving the needs of the
12 people of Guam; now therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, that *I Mina' Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
14 behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend Ms. Mary Jane V.
15 Sebastian for her twenty eight (28) years of service to the people of Guam and
16 expresses sincere gratitude for her contributions to the Department of Military
17 Affairs *and be it further*

18 RESOLVED, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee of
19 Rules certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to the adoption hereof
20 and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Ms. Mary Jane V.
21 Sebastian; to Major General Donald Goldhom, the Adjutant General of the
22 Guam National Guard; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahren*
23 *Guåhan*.
