

4 launched in 1988 gained its initial accreditation in 1996; and

5 WHEREAS, recently, the program was notified that the National
6 League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. has again given UOG's
7 Bachelor of Science in Nursing program the longest accreditation period
8 possible -- eight-years; and

9 WHEREAS, the accreditation comes after the School of Nursing and
10 Health Sciences worked tirelessly throughout the two-year process that
11 included comprehensive self-study and a visit by the National League for
12 Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. evaluators; and


