1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN**
2 **GUÅHAN:**

3 **WHEREAS,** Jane Sablan Aguon Lizama was born on July 29, 1936 in
4 Barrigada. Her parents are Vicente Losongco Aguon and Juanita Taitano
5 Sablan ; and

7 **WHEREAS,** Jane A. Lizama or Mrs. Lizama graduated from George
8 Washington High School in 1955; and

10 **WHEREAS,** Mrs. Lizama started her unprecedented dedication with Guam
11 Legislature on July 6, 1955 when she was hired as Clerk Stenographer I
12 during the 3rd Guam Legislature; and

1 **WHEREAS**, On March 1, 1956, Mrs. Lizama was promoted to Clerk
2 Stenographer III. She was promoted again on January 1, 1958 to Recording
3 Secretary and Journal Entry Clerk during the 4th Guam Legislature; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lizama was reclassified to Legislative Recording
6 Secretary in April 5 , 1959 until the 7th Guam Legislature; and
7

8 **WHEREAS**, She was hired as an Administrative Secretary at the Office of
9 the Governor in January 18, 1965 then went back to work with 9th Guam
10 Legislature as the Recording Secretary in January 3, 1967; and
11

12 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lizama's continued her superior performance as Chief
13 Clerk, Office Administrator, Recording Secretary , Section Supervisor ,
14 Legal Officer, Recording Secretary Supervisor from 11th Guam Legislature
15 to the 23rd Guam Legislature; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Because of her excellent performance in her duties, record of
18 experience, loyalty and dedication, having rendered a total of thirty-four
19 (34) years of government service, Mrs. Lizama was given a recognition and
20 meritorious bonus by 23rd Guam Legislature through a Legislative
21 Resolution in October 1996; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lizama retired as Recording Secretary Supervisor of the
24 23rd Guam Legislature on January 3, 1997; and

3 Aryana Therease, brothers, sisters, cousins , family and friends ; now

Relative to recognizing the unprecedented dedication and superior performance of the Recording Secretary of the Twenty-Third Guam Legislature, and to authorizing a meritorious bonus therefor.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF THE
2 TWENTY-THIRD GUAM LEGISLATURE:

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jane Lizama, the Recording Secretary and Supervisor
4 of the Legal Office, Twenty-Third Guam Legislature, has demonstrated
5 excellent performance in her duties, and, being senior in service than any
6 other staff member or any of the incumbent senators, has earned the respect
7 and admiration of all in the Legislature; and

8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Lizama's record of experience, loyalty, and dedication
9 is one beyond comparison, having rendered a total of thirty-four (34) years of
10 government service, beginning as an employee with the Fourth Guam
11 Legislature and through the current Legislature, except during the Eighth
12 Guam Legislature where she worked at the Governor's Office, and six (6)
13 additional years as a contractual employee, while serving as an Attaché with

1 the Legislature; and

2 WHEREAS, the untiring efforts of Mrs. Lizama and her extensive
3 personal knowledge of the workings of the Legislature, especially the day-to-
4 day operations of the Legal Office, have assured her invaluable contribution
5 to the Legislature and resulted in her continued employment with the
6 Legislature, having maintained the confidence of the senators to the extent
7 that she held the position of Minority Staff Administrator when the
8 Democrats were not the majority Party; and

9 WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Committee on Rules that the
10 unparalleled record of Mrs. Lizama, employed by this branch of government
11 since the Fourth Guam Legislature, should not go unrecognized, and that she
12 is most deserving of a meritorious bonus, long overdue, as a tribute to her
13 superior performance; now, therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, that notwithstanding any other provisions of rules,
15 regulations, or administrative practices, the Committee on Rules of the
16 Twenty-Third Guam Legislature does hereby recognize the superior
17 performance and long service of Mrs. Lizama, and does authorize her a
18 meritorious bonus in an amount equal to three (3) months of regular
19 compensation; and be it further

20 RESOLVED, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Committee on
21 Rules certify to and the Legislative Secretary attest the adoption hereof and
22 that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Mrs. Jane Lizama; to the
23 Executive Director, Twenty-Third Guam Legislature; and to the Governor of
24 Guam.


