3 WHEREAS, Imelda David Santos, lovingly known to her family, friends,
4 students and colleagues as "Mel" , was born on November 1, 1937 in Sta.
5 Rita , Pampanga , Philippines; and

7 WHEREAS, Imelda David Santos is a resident of Barrigada where she lives
8 with his husband, Val Santos and daughter Karina A. Santos; and

10 WHEREAS, Imelda David Santos is a graduate of St. Louis University of
11 Baguio and Ateneo de Manila University in Philippines.

13 WHEREAS, after finishing her masters at Rockville Maryland, Imelda
14 David Santos began her professional career in Guam in 1967 as teacher
15 with St. John's School in Upper Tumon, Guam ; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in 1970, Imelda D. Santos she was chosen as Principal of St.
2 John's School; and

4 **WHEREAS**, because of her commitment to excellence in education and
5 her relentless displayed of exceptional dedication, knowledge and skills as
6 an educator, the St. John's School Lower Building was dedicated to her in
7 1998. The reconstructed school building was named I.D. Santos School
8 Building; and

10 **WHEREAS**, from 2004-2005 , Imelda D. Santos was the Head Mistress of
11 the St. John's School and became the Dean of Students in 2006 ; and

13 **WHEREAS**, during her 40 years with St. John's School, Imelda D. Santos
14 inspired students of all backgrounds, had the respect and admiration of
15 students, parents, and colleagues and played an active and useful role in
16 the community as well as in the school

18 **WHEREAS**, many of Imelda D. Santos former students are very fond of her
19 and still keep in touch with her over the years. She is also known for her
20 generosity and her ability to remember each students of St. John's School;

23 **WHEREAS**, throughout the past forty (40) years, Imelda D. Santos's
24 dedication and commitment to education , has positively impacted and
25 contributed to the development, progress and success of education and
26 educating in Guam ; now therefore be it;
