BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:

1 **WHEREAS**, Chief Master Sergeant John S.N. Martinez is the
2 devoted husband of Florence Paulino Martinez and the proud father of
3 three children, all of whom have continued the family legacy of joining
4 the armed forces: SSgt Lance Martinez, A1C Christina Martinez and
5 A1C John Martinez; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Chief Martinez is the Command Chief Master
7 Sergeant for the Guam Air National Guard Headquarters and works on
8 behalf of the Adjutant General of Guam; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Chief Martinez is the Air National Guard senior
10 listed advisor and is responsible for all affairs concerning the enlisted
11 personnel of the Guam Air National Guard; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Chief Martinez embarked on his military career by
13 enlisting as a traditional guardsman in the Guam Air National Guard
14 on July 1982 as an Engineering Assistance Trainee with the 254th Civil
15 Engineering Flight; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Chief Martinez completed the Air Force Basic
17 Military Training and the Engineering Assistance Apprentice Course in
18 March 1983; and

19 **WHEREAS**, upon completion of his Bachelors of Arts Degree in
20 Psychology and Education from the University of Guam in 1984, he
21 subsequently retrained into the Training career field as the Unit
22 Training Manager in 1986; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Chief Martinez took an active duty position for a
24 period of four years in July of 1989 as the Base Training Manager for the
25 254th Air Base Group; and

26 **WHEREAS**, Chief Martinez has held numerous positions in the
27 Military Personnel Flight prior to becoming the Recruiter for the Guam
28 Air National Guard in June 2000; and

29 **WHEREAS**, Chief Martinez was promoted in June of 2004 to be
30 the first Personnel and Recruiting Superintendent for the 254th Air Base
31 Group; and

32 **WHEREAS**, Chief Martinez was selected to be the 4th Command
33 Chief for the Guam Air National Guard in April 2006; and

34 **WHEREAS**, throughout his professional career, Chief Martinez
35 has accumulated many awards and decorations, to include the
36 Meritorious Service Medal with oak leaf cluster, the Air Force
37 Commendation Medal with 2 oak leaf clusters, the Air Force
38 Achievement Medal, the Army Achievement Medal, the Joint
39 Meritorious Service Medal, the Air Reserve Forces Meritorious Service
40 medal with 1 silver and 2 oak leaf clusters, the Air Force Outstanding
41 Unit Award, the National Defense Service medal, the Armed Forces
42 Reserve Medal, the Air Force Longevity Service Award Ribbon with 1

43 silver leaf cluster, and the Air Force Training Ribbon; now, therefore,
