Relative to commending the Principal, Teachers, and Students of Yamagata Prefectural, Tokai Daigaku Yamagata High School, Japan for their visit to Guam to pay respects to the Victims of World War II in Guam, and to promote peace and fellowship through their visit to Guam, and to thank Mr. Kensuke Haga and U.S. Explore and Study Inc. for their work on the project.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA' TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

1 **WHEREAS**, a group of fifty-three (53) high school students and
2 their advisors from Japan visited Guam for the purpose of showing
3 respect and prayer for those who died during World War II; and

4 **WHEREAS**, those students visited the War in the Pacific National
5 Park, Gaan Point, Faha Massacre site and Manenggon Memorial Park in
6 order to better understand the horrors of war and its effects on both the
7 soldiers who fought it and the innocent civilians caught in its wake; and

8 **WHEREAS**, it is hoped that this will continue to be an annual
9 trip, and that the tribute paid by these high school students will shine as
10 an example that will encourage other students and organizations from
11 Japan to make similar trips; and

12 **WHEREAS**, *U.S. Explore & Study, Inc.*, has been instrumental in
13 trying to heal the wounds of World War II and tensions over the war
14 between the people of Japan, Guam, and the United States, and has held
15 ceremonies and tributes in the past years with that noble aim; and

16 **WHEREAS**, *U.S. Explore & Study, Inc.*, along with its president,
17 Mr. Kensuke Haga, have worked extremely hard to move towards these
18 goals and especially to help organize this trip by Japanese high school
19 students; now, therefore, be it

20 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
21 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam,
22 highly commend and thank the Principal, Teachers and Students from
23 Yamagata Prefectural, Tokai Daigaku Yamagata High School for visiting

24 Guam and the World War II sites, and honoring those who died at those
25 sites, with their prayer and tribute; and be it further

26 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the
27 Committee of Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the
28 adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to
29 the Principal, Teachers and Students from Yamagata Prefectural, Tokai
30 Daigaku Yamagata High School, Mr. Kensuke Haga; and to the
31 Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
