Relative to posthumously commending Maria Delgado San Nicolas Leon Guerrero for her tireless dedication to the people of Guam, and to extending condolences to her family for their loss.

3 WHEREAS, communities thrive under the leadership of public servants;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, being a small island, these leaders are more important on
6 Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Maria Delgado San Nicolas Leon Guerrero (*familian*
2 *Hilario*) was born on August 06, 1921 and was called from this life on
3 November 09, 2010; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Leon Guerrero was the first female to be elected
5 Assistant Commissioner (now known as Vice-Mayor) on Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS**, she served as the Assistant Commissioner for Tamuning-
7 Tumon-Harmon from 1969-1977, where she focused on improving the lives of
8 her villages' youth; and

9 **WHEREAS**, she was also the first residential manager for *Guma'*
10 *Trankilidat*, holding that position for many years; and

11 **WHEREAS**, she helped our people struggling the with the dream of
12 homeownership as an employee of Guam Housing and Urban Renewal
13 Authority (GHURA); and

14 **WHEREAS**, her public service also extended to the Legislature, where
15 she worked under Senator Tommy Tanaka and Speaker (then-Senator) Antonio
16 Unpingco; and

17 **WHEREAS**, her dedication to this island was also felt in the religious
18 community, where she served in the Christian Mothers of Tamuning; and

19 **WHEREAS**, she joins her husband Carlos Sablan Leon Guerrero (*familian*
20 *Bino/Te*), and her parents Juan Guerrero and Rosa Delgado San Nicolas, her
21 parents in-law Juan Cabrera and Joaquina Torres Sablan Leon Guerrero in
22 eternal life; and

1 **WHEREAS**, she is survived by her five children and their spouses: John
2 William and Marsha Johnston Leon Guerrero, Charles Raymond and Julie
3 Franquez Leon Guerrero Perez, Joseph Victor and Barbara (Bobbi) Perez Leon
4 Guerrero, Carmen Lou and Chat Penaranda, and Gloria Jean and Alex Santos
5 Achivida, and her seventeen (17) grandchildren and thirteen (13) great-
6 grandchildren; now therefore, be it

7 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
8 behalf of the people of Guam, posthumously commend Maria Delgado San
9 Nicolas Leon Guerrero for her tireless dedication to the people of Guam; and be
