



3 WHEREAS, Major General Donald James Goldhorn was born in South
4 Dakota on September 12, 1944; and

5
6 WHEREAS, Major General Goldhorn is married to Janet C. Goldhorn.
7 They have three beautiful children Corey J. Goldhorn, Anne G. Ruane and
8 Bradley J. Goldhorn; and

9
10 WHEREAS, Major General Goldhorn graduated from Huron College in
11 Huron, South Dakota in 1966 with Bachelor of Arts in Psychology. He also
12 graduated from Northern State University, Aberdeen South Dakota with
13 Master in Science in Guidance and Counseling; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in 1969, he completed the Medical Services Officers Basic
2 Course and completed the Medical Department Advance Office Course in
3 1974. He graduated from Army Command and General Staff College in
4 1980 and completed his Army War College in 1995; and

5
6 **WHEREAS**, Major General Goldhorn was commissioned as a First
7 Lieutenant in the Medical Service Corps in 1969; and

8
9 **WHEREAS**, Major General Goldhorn served 11 months in Vietnam where
10 he held command positions with the 51st Medical Company and the
11 Headquarters Detachment of the 67th EVAC Hospital; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Major General Goldhorn commanded South Dakota's 147th
14 Field Artillery Brigade and served three years as the Chief of Staff for the
15 Guam Army National Guard from November 1995 to March 1999; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Major General Goldhorn served as Assistant Adjutant
18 General for South Dakota Army National Guard from March 1999 to
19 August 2010; and

21 **WHEREAS**, after retiring in September 2001, Major General Goldhorn
22 assumed the duties of Adjutant General , Guam National Guard on March
23 18, 2005 ; and

25 **WHEREAS**, his many awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit
26 (with Oak Leaf Cluster), Bronze Star, Meritorious Service Medal (with Oak
27 Leaf Cluster) , Army Commendation Medal for his actions in saving the
28 life of a soldier and the Guam Commendation Medal and Humanitarian
29 Award for his actions in recovery efforts of victims from the crash of
30 Korean Airlines Flight 801; and

32 **WHEREAS**, as the Adjutant General, he is the principle advisor to the
33 Governor of Guam on all military matters, and is directly responsible for
34 the readiness, management and combat effectiveness of more than 1,400

1 men and women of the Guam Army and Air National Guard; now,
2 therefore be it
