WHEREAS, children who must deal with such traumatic losses easily endure emotional instability, insecurity, and the loss of self-esteem and self-confidence, thereby resulting in poor academic performance, as well as social behavioral problems; and

WHEREAS, grief that is left unattended can lead kids to join gangs, live an unhealthy lifestyle behavior, experience teenage pregnancies, abuse alcohol and drugs, have failed relationships, or be at risk of suicide; and

WHEREAS, experts have found that one of the most effective ways to reach out to such children is through their schools, since these children spend most of their day in school interacting with other students, teachers, counselors, and other adults in their schools, who could help them deal with their loss, as well as provide emotional support; and

WHEREAS, for the past twenty-six (26) years, Rainbows for All Children-Guam has made a difference in the lives of over 15,500 children and their families. The group of certified facilitators, coordinators and educators, led by its Executive Director, Marie Virata Halloran, holds fourteen (14) sessions per school year to groups of kids that are going through various kinds and stages of grief situations; and

WHEREAS, to culminate the organization's yearly group sessions, the Rainbows for All Children-Guam has organized *Celebrate Me Days*, a day spent with parents/guardians, Rainbow children and their siblings. During the event, the organization promotes the virtue of forgiveness and elucidates its mantra: "Rainbows Mend Hearts, Inspire Minds"; and
