1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN***

2        ***GUÅHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS**, through the adoption of Resolution No. 25-32(COR), *I*  
4        *Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognized and commended the Association of Government  
5        Accountants (AGA) for its contributions to the field of accounting across our  
6        country and our island; including the recognition of the AGA Citizen-Centric  
7        Government Reporting Initiative, which was launched a few years ago with the

1 intent to foster innovative means of communication between governments and their  
2 citizenry; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Doreen Crisostomo, University of Guam (UOG) Professor,  
4 first introduced her students to the Citizen-Centric Government Reporting Initiative  
5 in her Spring 2009 BA401 “Government Accounting” class. Dr. Crisostomo  
6 incorporated the initiative into her syllabus to complement classroom learning and  
7 give her students exposure to real-world experiences through interacting with our  
8 local government agencies to compile various citizen-centric reports (CCR) for each  
9 agency involved; and

10 **WHEREAS**, last year, AGA National kicked-off its Sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) Annual  
11 Government Finance Case Challenge, inviting the best undergraduate  
12 accounting/financial management/business students in the country to compete.  
13 Student teams were to collaboratively analyze and offer a written response to a case  
14 centered on how a U.S. city government creates a CCR; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Doreen Crisostomo, UOG Accounting Professor, formed a  
16 four (4) member student team from her Fall 2012 BA401 “Government Accounting”  
17 class, of which Ms. Angeline Corpuz Nieto was a member. Under the guidance of  
18 Dr. Crisostomo, the team of Nieto, Mr. Steven Patrick Delgado, Ms. Cindelle Maye  
19 O. Sazon and Mr. Russell Jon Miranda Bala-an entered the AGA National’s  
20 competition to prepare a citizen-centric report for the Loudoun County Public  
21 Schools, Virginia; to include a paper that summarizes the criteria and the  
22 justification the team used to decide what information to include and exclude in the  
23 performance report; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the UOG team of Nieto, Delgado, Sazon and Bala-an,  
25 successfully placed as one of the top two (2) finalist teams, along with North  
26 Carolina State University; and

1           **WHEREAS**, all finalist teams were awarded scholarships to attend the  
2 AGA’s 2013 National Leadership Conference in Washington, D.C., which the UOG  
3 team accepted; and

4           **WHEREAS**, through the adoption of Resolution No. 25-32(COR), *I*  
5 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognized, commended and offered its well wishes to the  
6 UOG team, who attended the Conference held on February 12-13, 2013; and

7           **WHEREAS**, all two (2) finalist teams presented their finalized solutions on  
8 February 12, 2013 before a panel of judges comprised of federal, state and local  
9 government leaders; corporate partners; and chief financial officers; and

10           **WHEREAS**, on February 13, 2013, the judges’ selection was announced, and  
11 the UOG team was selected as this year’s AGA Government Finance Case  
12 Challenge winners. In addition to the honor and recognition of holding the position  
13 as this year’s winning team, each member of the team will also receive a cash prize  
14 and a free one (1) year AGA membership; and

15           **WHEREAS**, the AGA followed through on its promise that this experience  
16 would challenge students' moral reasoning, raise their awareness of the importance  
17 of government accountability, and open doors to a future career in government; and

18           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Nieto, her teammates and their advisor, followed through  
19 on their promise to work their hardest and try their best, for themselves, for our  
20 University, and for our island; no, therefore, be it

21           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
22 on behalf of the people of Guam, commend and congratulate Ms. Angeline Corpuz  
23 Nieto on her accomplishments as a member of the University of Guam’s winning  
24 team of the Association of Government Accountants’ Annual Government Finance  
25 Case Challenge; and does further extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu’os Ma’åse’* to Ms.  
26 Nieto for her contributions to our community by way of her positive representation  
27 of our island, which extends farther than our boundaries and puts Guam on the map,

2 nation's Capitol; and be it further
