- WHEREAS, Ms. Reina R. Sanchez is currently a Social Services Supervisor I
- 4 at the Department of Mental Health and Social Services (DMHSA) since March 2001.

1 Ms. Sanchez is a professional individual whose qualifications are exceptional as seen

2 through her services and academic experiences. She received her Bachelor of Social

3 Work Degree from our very own University of Guam (UOG) in 1990. Later, she

4 pursued further education and received her Master in Counseling Degree from the

University of Guam in May 2012. In addition, she has received numerous trainings in

social work administration and supervision; and

WHEREAS, in her work as a Social Services Supervisor, Reina heads the Community Services Support Branch of the Clinical Services Division at the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse. Part of this supervision includes extremely high caseload management of consumers with chronic mental health disabilities. On the occasions when she is needed, Ms. Sanchez is also tasked to act as the Clinical Administrator, overseeing the entire clinical services department. Typically, this position is held by a Clinical Psychologist and Ms. Sanchez has been able to work in this capacity from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Sanchez also conducts numerous programs and resource developments, inclusive of the residential homes program within DMHSA that provides housing assistance to those consumers with chronic mental illnesses. Besides her supervisory duties, Reina also has collateral duties that include representation on the Guam Homeless Coalition and the Adult State Planner for Community Mental Health Services (CMHS) Block Grant; as well as providing field instruction to UOG students, for both the Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) and Psychology interns. Reina is also the Behavior Health Disaster and Crisis Response Assistant Coordinator for DMHSA. Given the recent tragedy in *Tumon*, Ms. Sanchez was able to ensure that the counselors and other staff are ready to assist for any mental health crisis when needed by Guam's community at any given time; and

WHEREAS, prior to all this, Ms. Sanchez was a Social Worker III, also at the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse. She was originally involved and was a member of the Guam Association of Social Workers prior to its merging with the National Association of Social Workers in 1999; and

WHEREAS, one of the greatest highlights of Reina's profession as a social work professional is advocating for her consumers. Helping her consumers in their personal recovery is Ms. Sanchez's primary goal. She is instrumental in assisting consumers become a part of their recovery process. Reina is dedicated to ensuring that consumers receive quality care that is focused on their holistic needs. She is compassionate and is willing to work long hours without pay to pursue resources that will support the expansion of services not only for her unit, but also for other agencies servicing individuals with disabilities. Finding Reina in her office way past the five oclock work hour is not unusual, which speaks volumes of her dedication to her staff, as well as to the consumers they serve; and

WHEREAS, Reina is always available to listen to her staff and be a sounding board when others need to vent. She sees challenges as opportunities to learn and grow, and meets these challenges head on. She likes to think "outside the box" and sometimes she gets "glassy," where she looks from subordinates and other colleagues alike. Like many of the employees at DMHSA, she is grace under fire when there are deadlines and finds humor in even the most stressful situations. No matter how difficult the situation she is facing, Reina has the grace to be ever so patient and understanding, and so "cool" under pressure. She is greatly respected by her staff and colleagues, and is often referred to as the "walking manual" of DMHSA; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Sanchez has worked with people with disabilities for over 25 years. She had worked for a short period of time at *GumaMami*, Incorporated, and

1 then at DMHSA, where she has been for the past 24 years. She also took a part-time

job with Catholic Social Service under the Guidance and Counseling program; and

WHEREAS, Reina's involvement in the block grant led to the development of the *Sagan Mami* programs. This program supports consumers with mental illnesses by providing a mental health resource center, supported employment and peer support. This program continues to thrive and is a great resource to our consumers with mental health disabilities. If social workers have a hard time finding their consumers, they

can always count on looking for them at Sagan Mami; and

WHEREAS, not only is Reina a hard working and dedicated employee, she's also a loving single parent who has raised four children single-handedly. While raising her children, she managed to complete her BSW Degree in 1990. Further, while working full-time in her current employment and position as a Social Services Supervisor, Reina managed to complete her Master in Counseling Degree at the University of Guam. She will continue to work for her hours in order to obtain licensure for Individual, Marriage and Family Therapy (IMFT) and become a licensed IMFT therapist on Guam; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Sanchez's hard work and dedication in servicing the most vulnerable in our island community while upholding the highest standards of the social work profession is commendable as seen through her numerous achievements; now therefore, be it
