- 3 WHEREAS, the Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association is a non-
- 4 profit organization that was founded in 1965 to provide services at Guam's only

WHEREAS, the mission of the Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association is to work in partnership with the Guam Memorial Hospital in rendering voluntary services to the hospital, and its patients, families and visitors; and to engage in fundraising activities to secure funds to purchase critically needed hospital equipment; and

WHEREAS, the GMHVA members are involved in many different volunteer roles, and they have the opportunity to assist in the various programs or projects managed by the Association and the Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the GMHVA volunteers operate the Gift Shop, where they provide a shopping area for visitors and staff of the Hospital; as well as the Shopping Gift Cart that is wheeled around to patients' rooms by two volunteers to give patients and their visitors the opportunity to buy what they need and allow them to visit with the volunteers; and

WHEREAS, the GMHVA has extended the hours of operation of the Gift Shop to include evening hours to continue to serve the Hospital staff and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the GMHVA volunteers also assist by greeting visitors at an information booth at the entrance of the Hospital; providing baby photo services, grooming services and interpreting services; visiting patients, especially the children in the Pediatrics Department; assisting different hospital departments with administrative tasks; providing a quarterly newsletter; conducting various fundraising projects, and many other services; and

WHEREAS, during the holiday season, GMHVA volunteers bring gifts to all of the Hospital's patients and sing Christmas carols. On the Feast of the Three Kings, the Association hosts a luncheon for the Skilled Nursing Unit patients and staff, distribute gifts to the patients, and sing Christmas carols to bring them cheer. The GMHVA also won 3rd place at the GPO/Dr. Shieh's Christmas Tree competition; and

WHEREAS, the GMHVA played an instrumental part in assisting the tourist victims of the stabbing and vehicular assault incident in *Tumon* in February. The volunteers visited the victims in the Hospital and gave them gifts and get well cards, and assisted the Hospital with finding interpreters for the victims; and WHEREAS, since the inception of the GMHVA, its members have contributed countless volunteer service hours and have purchased more than \$5 Million Dollars worth of equipment through the generous support of the community; and WHEREAS, in 2012 alone, GMHVA purchased nearly \$200,000 worth of hospital equipment, which included cardiac monitors, wheelchairs, lifts, ultrasound equipment parts, and other various donations; and WHEREAS, the "National Volunteer Week," which is celebrated in April each year, provides a national and local focus to promote and recognize the value of volunteering in the community. During this week, the GMHVA hosts several events to recognize and thank members for their efforts; and WHEREAS, during "National Volunteer Week," the GMHVA volunteers are given awards of recognition and appreciation.
