- 3 WHEREAS, the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse is the
- 4 state agency which provides mental health care services for children, youth and

- 1 adolescents, young adults and adults, whose vision is: "That more caring
- 2 communities will be visible throughout the island in promoting positive mental
- 3 health and healthy lifestyle through prevention and education strategies; and that
- 4 the practice of ensuring delivery of mandated mental health services reflects
- 5 collaborative engagement and a Standard of Excellence"; and
- 6 WHEREAS, on our island of Guåhan, we all experience difficulty and
- 7 stress with our everyday dealings with life, and oftentimes some may require
- 8 mental health intervention. Positive mental health is essential to the well-being of
- 9 every child, woman, and man in the community, our nation and our world. The
- participation of the community as a whole serves an integral role in caring for the
- well-being of individuals seeking help; and
- WHEREAS, mental illness does not discriminate. Anyone at any given
- time, regardless of age, gender, race, social status or income level, can be affected.

- provided, as these services are crucial to the needs of affected individuals and their

- 21 recovery and awareness, in order to combat stigma and discrimination which
- 22 hinders individuals from seeking mental health services; and

- 4 in the United States, often resulting in many days of work lost annually, due to a

- 8 WHEREAS, advocacy for sound social policies is significant, and to have
