- 2 MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:
- WHEREAS, Mr. Antonio S. Dimalanta, FUAP, AIA, a long-time architect
- 4 and engineer, was born on April 11, 1918, in Manila, Philippines; and he was a
- 5 devoted husband of the late †Pilar Fernandez Perez; a loving father of seven (7)
- 6 children: Albert, Antonio Jr., Augusto, Asuncion, Adelina, Ariel and Anita; and a

- loving grandfather and great grandfather of twenty-six (26) grandchildren, and
- 2 twenty-seven (27) great-grandchildren; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Dimalanta received his Bachelor's Degree of Science in
- 4 Architecture from the University of Santo Tomas, Philippines, in 1940; he
- 5 completed his studies in Military Engineering at the Engineering School in Fort
- 6 Belvior, Virginia, USA, in 1945; he received a Bachelor's Degree of Science in
- 7 Civil Engineering from the University of Santo Tomas, Philippines, in 1949; and
- 8 he furthered his academic career with post graduate studies in Structural
- 9 Engineering and Business Management at the University of California, Los
- 10 Angeles, in 1958; and
- WHEREAS, during and after World War II, from 1941 to 1948, Mr.
- 12 Dimalanta was a Commissioned Officer in the United States Armed Forces in the
- 13 Far East Engineer (USAFFEE), and an Engineering Officer of the Armed Forces of
- 14 the Philippines (AFP); and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Dimalanta first began his professional career after World
- War II ended, and from 1948 to 1952, he was engaged in private practice as an
- 17 architect in Manila, Philippines; and
- 18 WHEREAS, from 1952 to 1955, Mr. Dimalanta worked on Guam for Frank
- 19 D. Perez & Bros., and he was assigned to the position of Lead Architect in the
- 20 design of the first ever Archdiocese Catholic Church of Guam, the *Dulce Nombre*
- 21 de Maria (Sweet Name of Mary) Cathedral Basilica in Hagåtña, the capital city of
- 22 Guam; and with then Bishop Apollinaris William Baumgartner, he designed the
- 23 homes of former Governor Paul McDonald Calvo, Mr. Jerry Calvo, Mr. Edward
- 24 M. Calvo, Mr. and Mrs. Peter and Kathy Sgro, Mr. Henry Schnabel, Mr. Ronald
- 25 Schnabel, Mr. Frank Perez and Mr. Greg Perez; and he was also involved in the
- development of the Perezville neighborhood in the village of Tamuning, and he
- designed numerous prominent family residences on Guam; and

WHEREAS, the late Mr. Dimalanta was a man of strong faith, a devoted parishioner of the St. Anthony/St. Victor Catholic Church in Tamuning, and he helped to bring the Cursillo Movement to the Guam Catholic community in 1969; and WHEREAS, Mr. Dimalanta's culture and heritage were very important to him, which inspired him to organize the members of the Filipino community on Guam. In 1954, he became the first President of the Filipino Community of Guam (FCG), an organization which has been an important and influential social group on Guam for many years; and WHEREAS, Mr. Dimalanta had worked for Daniel, Mann, Johnson, and Menedenhal on Guam, from 1955 to 1958; and later, he was based out of Tokyo, working for Trans-Asia Engineering Associates Inc., which made him desire to have a branch of the firm based in the Philippines; and after encouraging the management of Trans-Asia Engineering Associates, they assigned him to work at their new Manila venture; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dimalanta was the Project Manager in Manila, Philippines, until 1965; and when Trans-Asia Engineering Associates (Phils), Inc., became incorporated, Mr. Dimalanta automatically became its first President, and served from 1965 until he retired in 1983. In 1984, Mr. Dimalanta formed ASD and Associates, a consulting firm for Manila and Guam, and he became the Chairman of the Board for Trans Asia in the mid 1980s; now therefore, be it
