WHEREAS, in 1999, Mr. Isotoff served as a project manager for the Palau Road Project for Matson Logistics Solutions, a subsidiary of Matson Navigation Company; and a year later, Mr. Isotoff formally joined Matson Logistics as the Manager for Logistics in Guam; and in 2000, Mr. Isotoff was promoted to the position of Manager of Sales and Customer Service, Matson Navigation Company, Guam and Micronesia; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Isotoff continued to climb the ladder in his maritime career, receiving a promotion in 2003 and becoming the Manager of Sales for the Pacific Northwest with Matson Navigation Company in Seattle, Washington; and in 2006, Mr. Isotoff was once again promoted and served as the Manager of Container Operations with Matson Navigation Company in Honolulu, Hawaii; and WHEREAS, in 2008, Mr. Isotoff returned to Guam to take the helm as the General Manager of Matson Navigation Company, Guam and Micronesia, where he continued the positive and collaborative relationship between Matson and the Port Authority of Guam, the islands of Micronesia, and the western Pacific region;
