WHEREAS, autism is a complex developmental disability that typically appears during the first three years of a child's life and affects their ability to communicate and interact with others; and there is no known single cause for autism, but increased awareness and funding can help families today; and

WHEREAS, autism is defined by a certain set of behaviors and is a "spectrum disorder" that affects individuals differently, to varying degrees; and autism is four times more prevalent in boys than in girls and knows no racial, ethnic, or social boundaries. In 2009, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention issued its autism prevalence report and concluded that the prevalence of autism had risen to one in every eighty-eight births in the United States, and that it is five times more common among boys, at almost one in fifty-four boys, compared to one in two hundred fifty-two girls; and

WHEREAS, thirteen million American families are now living with the effects of autism spectrum disorder, and the Autism Society currently estimates that the lifetime cost of caring for a child with autism is in the range of \$3.2 million; and

WHEREAS, the United States faces almost one hundred twenty-six billion dollars annually in costs for autism; and together with appropriate education and intervention, are vital to the future growth and development of individuals with autism; and

WHEREAS, through the increased awareness, and the services available to individuals with autism, the lives of our friends and family members with autism can be made easier, while those without autism can expand their understanding of the needs and challenges that individuals with autism experience; and

WHEREAS, parents and family members, support groups, researchers, and professionals have dedicated years of service in their ongoing efforts to advocate for the rights, respect, dignity, humane treatment, and appropriate education of all persons

with autism; and in order to highlight the growing need for concern and awareness

2 about autism, the Autism Society has celebrated "National Autism Awareness Month"

since the 1970s in the United States, recognizing the month of April as a time of

special opportunity to educate the public about autism, and the issues within the

autism community; and

WHEREAS, the Governor signed a proclamation declaring April 2014 as "Autism Awareness Month," a time when every resident of Guam is invited to participate in activities that educate and promote awareness of autism spectrum disorders that affect members of our community and their families; and

WHEREAS, Autism Community Together (ACT), which was formed in January 2004, has continued to spearhead an awareness effort in order to educate parents, professionals, and the general public about autism and its effects; and various activities are being coordinated throughout the month of April 2014 to further these goals, including, a fair at the *Agaña* Shopping Center, located in the capital city of *Hagåtña*, where approximately forty vendors will participate in featuring informational displays to disseminate and spread awareness relative to education, employment, career, and many related service agencies; garner support for our families who will be participating in the Special Olympics this year; and feature a day of bowling for the families affected by autism; now therefore, be it
