3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Lee M. Holmes, from the village of *Tamuning*, was born on**
4 **December 25, 1930, in Quantico, Virginia; and he was married to Joan Holmes who**

1 passed away from cancer on February 1, 2007, after fifty-one and a half (51½) years
2 of marriage. They are the parents of Bryan and Mark Holmes; and they have three (3)
3 loving grandchildren; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Holmes married Ann Silliman on December 13, 2012; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Holmes received his education from the United States Naval
6 Academy; and he has a Masters in Science in Aeronautics and Astronautics from the
7 Massachusetts Institute of Technology; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Holmes' extensive work experiences include: serving as the
9 Rifle Platoon Commander with the 1st Marine Division in Korea; as a Fighter Pilot in
10 El Toro, California; as the F-111 Radar and Fire Control Systems Manager of General
11 Dynamics in Fort Worth, Texas; as the President of the Resources and Technology
12 Management Company in Boston, Massachusetts; as the President of Guam Cable
13 TV, Hit Radio 100, KFVE-TV, and Pacific Color Press; and as a Colonel in the U.S.
14 Marine Corps; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Holmes had served for twenty-eight (28) years in the U.S.
16 Marine Corps and the U.S. Marine Corps Reserve; and he had received special
17 training in Marine Officers Basic School, Reconnaissance School, and Flight
18 Training; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Holmes first started with Guam Cable TV on August 4, 1971,
20 until it was sold to Marianas Cable Vision (MCV) on December 16, 1997, the day
21 before Typhoon *Paka* hit Guam. His sons, Bryan and Mark, continued to work at
22 Guam Cable TV during their vacations from Father Dueñas Memorial School and
23 college. Bryan had managed their Pasadena taping facility; and both sons managed
24 KFVE-TV in Honolulu until returning to Guam when Typhoon Omar struck the
25 island; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Holmes has been an active participant in community
2 organizations, such as the Guam Rotary Club, the Guam Chamber of Commerce, the
3 Father Dueñas Memorial School Parent Teacher Association, and the St. John’s
4 Episcopal Church; now therefore, be it

5 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
6 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of
7 Guam, recognize and commend Mr. Lee M. Holmes for his invaluable contributions
8 to our island community and its economy through establishing and managing
9 businesses, such as the former Guam Cable TV, Hit Radio 100, KFVE-TV, and
10 Pacific Color Press; and does further extend *Un Dângkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to him
