- 9 promoted to a Planner II position in 1993; and then promoted to a Planner III in 1998;

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Perez has diligently served under several Executive Branch
- 12 Administrations, with three (3) Governors serving two (2) consecutive four (4)-year
- terms. She has served under nine (9) government of Guam Directors, and she was
