**Relative to recognizing and congratulating the Guam Marianas Lions Club (GMLC) on the occasion of its Sixty-fifth (65<sup>th</sup>) Year Anniversary; and to further extending a warm and sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the GMLC for addressing the humanitarian needs of the people of our island and regional community.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2           ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS**, in 1949, Francis Scotty Moylan, a prominent business man from  
4           Hawaii who was a Lions Club member, came to Guam. In that same year, Mr.

1 Moylan chartered the Guam Lions Club, and the President was the Honorable Antonio  
2 B. Won Pat, former Guam Delegate to the U.S. Congress in Washington D.C.; and

3 **WHEREAS**, after six (6) years, the Marianas Lions Club was established under  
4 the presidency of Lion Felix Avellana; and the two (2) Lions Clubs existed until 1966;  
5 and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Lions Club and the Marianas Lions Club decided to  
7 merge under a new name, the Guam Marianas Lions Club; and the President of the  
8 Club at the time was Dave Sila; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Marianas Lions Club started to increase its  
10 membership, and decided to charter the Asia Pacific Lions Club; and

11 **WHEREAS**, another Lions Club was then established, the Far East Lions Club,  
12 whose members were all associated with the military; and

13 **WHEREAS**, a significant event in the history of the association occurred  
14 during the year of 1987, when the Lions Clubs International became the first all men  
15 major service club organization to admit women as members; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the Achang Bay Lions Club was chartered under Lion President  
17 William Rymer, past-President of the Guam Marianas Lions Club; and years later they  
18 renamed the club to the Southern Lions Club; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the first women Lions Club was established on Guam, the Hafa  
20 Adai Lions Club, under the strong leadership of Lion President Jam Maravilla; and

21 **WHEREAS**, in 1992, the Guamerica Lions Club and the Guåhan Paradise  
22 Lions Club were chartered. Leonor Guyos was the President of the Guamerica Lions  
23 Club, and Rolly Ricabar was the President of the Guåhan Lions Club; and a year later,  
24 in 1993, the Guam Paradise Lions Club was chartered, with Monina Moreno as its  
25 President; and

1           **WHEREAS**, within that same year, seven (7) more Lions Clubs were  
2 chartered, and were based in Saipan, Rota and Tinian; and

3           **WHEREAS**, an International Convention held in Australia was significant  
4 because two (2) of the past Presidents of the Guam Marianas Lions Club, Lion Dan  
5 Del Priore and Lion Leslie Moreno, met with International Director Enrique Lim,  
6 from District 331-Al Manila, Philippines, and discussed if the Lions Clubs on Guam  
7 could become a District. They became an Interim District 204 in the latter part of that  
8 same year, and the Interim Governor was past President Dan Del Priore; and

9           **WHEREAS**, the Lions Clubs of Guam were granted the Provisionary District  
10 204 by Lions Club International because of the more than seven hundred (700)  
11 members, and with a total of seventeen (17) Lions Clubs; and

12           **WHEREAS**, in 1997, the Guam Stars Lions Club and the Guam Executive  
13 Lions Club were chartered. The President of the Guam Stars Lions Club was Bernie  
14 Rising; and the President of the Guam Executive Lions Club was Jam Maravilla; and

15           **WHEREAS**, in 1998, more Lion Clubs were established, to include the  
16 following Lions Clubs and its Presidents: the Guam Rainbow Lions Club – Evan  
17 Carbolido; the Guam Sunshine Lions Club – Bernie Manglona; the Galaide Lions  
18 Club – Zeny Catchila; the Guam Masters Lions Club – Dok In Cho; the Guam  
19 Harmony Lions Club – Linda Tolan; the Guam Ifil Lions Club – Wil Castro; and the  
20 Guam Gadao Lions Club – Cavin Cho; and

21           **WHEREAS**, one of the most significant events in the history of District 204  
22 was District Lion Governor Art Salmoes being able to increase the Lion membership.  
23 During his term, five (5) Lions Clubs were chartered, making it a total of twenty-  
24 seven (27) Lions Clubs in our district, including in the Commonwealth of the  
25 Northern Mariana Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, Palau, and Pohnpei;  
26 and

1           **WHEREAS**, from 1999 to 2008, more Lions Clubs were chartered: the Guam  
2 Nightingale Lions Club; the Latte Stone Lions Club; the Guam Spirit Lions Club; the  
3 Pohnpei Lions Club; and the Marshall Islands Lions Club; and

4           **WHEREAS**, the Guam Marianas Lions Club, the first Lions Club on Guam,  
5 celebrates its Sixty-fifth (65<sup>th</sup>) Year Anniversary this year. Over the years, they have  
6 conducted many community service projects, including their flagship initiative: the  
7 Sight Conversion, Awareness and Action program. This effort provides vision  
8 examination services by a licensed optometrist to our indigent brothers and sisters on  
9 Guam, as well as in the neighboring islands of the Federated States of Micronesia and  
10 the Philippines. The Guam Marianas Lions Club has also provided thousands of free  
11 prescription reading glasses to the people of these communities; now therefore, be it

12           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*  
13 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
14 of Guam, recognize and congratulate the Guam Marianas Lions Club (GMLC) on the  
15 occasion of its Sixty-fifth (65<sup>th</sup>) Year Anniversary; and does further extend a warm  
16 and sincere *Un Dângkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the GMLC for addressing the  
17 humanitarian needs of the people of our island and regional community; and be it  
18 further

2 Lion Napoleon O. Carino and Lion Past President Macrino P. Vargas, 1<sup>st</sup> Year


