WHEREAS, Joaquin C. Flores was born and raised on Guam; and he is the

son of Damian C. Flores (deceased) and Concepcion C. Flores of Mongmong; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin C. Flores is married to Jayne T. Flores; and they have

three (3) children: Juliana, Olivia, and Isabel; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin C. Flores graduated from George Washington High

School in 1977; he earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering

from the University of Portland, Oregon, in 1981; and he received a Master of

10 Science Degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Missouri-Rolla in

11 1982; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin C. Flores became a Registered Professional Engineer of Guam in 1988; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin C. Flores started his public service at the Guam Power Authority working as a System Planning Engineer from February 1983 to October 1987. He was later promoted to System Planning Supervisor in November 1987, and then promoted to Assistant Manager of Engineering in December 1989. Joaquin was responsible for the development of the GPA Transmission and Distribution (T&D) Protection Guidelines, and the implementation of the state-of-the-art microprocessor based protective relays for T&D; and tripled GPA capital improvement requirements in support of T&D planning criteria; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin C. Flores ascended through the managerial tiers and became the Manager of Engineering in March 1994; and in January 2003, he was then subsequently appointed by the Consolidated Commission on Utilities to serve as the Assistant General Manager of Operations, before his appointment to serve as General Manager in August 2005; and

WHEREAS, over the past nine (9) years serving as General Manager, Mr. Flores has led GPA to what has now become a highly regarded utility service in the Pacific region; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin C. Flores' exemplary performance and achievements have contributed to dramatic improvements in how the GPA manages its system, resulting in savings to ratepayers in excess of 200 Million Dollars in fuel expenses, improved generation reliability and effective system dispatching, improved T&D delivery efficiency by reducing line loss to an all-time low of just over 6%, and improved customer services; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Flores was instrumental in the development of the Integrated Resource Plan (IRP), which is leading us to a new re-generation of GPA, to include: replacing older units with more efficient units that can burn more than one fuel; using cleaner fuels and more affordable fuels; the introduction of large scale power production using Solar PV and wind renewables; and finally, he helped to bring Smart Grid technologies to Guam, which are among some of his more significant accomplishments during his tenure as General Manager of GPA; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Flores, in his continued drive for excellence, has led GPA to finally reaching the highest financial credit rating ever, investment grade, and leading to three (3) very successful bond financings in 2010, 2012 and 2014; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Flores was instrumental in the construction of the Gloria B Nelson Public Service Facility, which is nearly complete and which will house the GPA and GWA Administration Personnel beginning in January 2015. This permanent home for GPA and GWA will convert rental payments to ratepayer equity, eventually saving additional rental expenses for years to come; now therefore, be it
