- WHEREAS, the theme for this year's RFT MARC Benefit Dinner,
- 4 "Embracing History, Celebrating Opportunities in a Time of Change", appropriately
- 5 recognizes the work of individuals, such as Dr. Wilfred P. Leon Guerrero, who have
- 6 dedicated their lives to shaping the development of post-secondary education on
- 7 Guam; and
- 8 **WHEREAS,** Dr. Wilfred P Leon Guerrero was born on February 12, 1942; and
- 9 is the son of Jose Santos Leon Guerrero, Sr. and Vicenta Sanchez San Agustin Leon
- 10 Guerrero. On December 30, 1960, he married Virginia Torres Artero; and they were
