COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesian Affairs; Human and Natural Resources, Election Reform, and Capitol District convened a public hearing on Wednesday, March 4, 2015 at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of **Mrs. Ann Roth to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board [Length of Term: Three (3) Years] whose appointment history is as follows:**

- Appointed by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo on January 30, 2015;
- Appointment packet forwarded to I Liheslatura on February 4, 2015;
- Packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on February 4, 2015.

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via e-mail and facsimile to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on February 23, 2015 (5-Day Notice), and again on February 26, 2015 (48-Hour Notice), thereby meeting the noticing requirements of the Open Government Law. Notices were also transmitted to various stakeholders.

Senator Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing for the reappointment of **Mrs. Ann Roth to serve as a Member of the Guam** Environmental Protection Agency (GEPA) Board to order at 9:00 A.M. and invited the panel to testify.

Senator Respicio called appointee up, Mrs. Ann Roth. Senator Respicio noted that the appointee is currently serving under the GEPA Board and that this was a re-appointment. He noted his appreciation for her to continue to serve on the Board. He then gave the nominee the opportunity to provide testimony before the Committee.

Mrs. Ann Roth

My name is Ann Marie Roth. This is my third time before the senators in the Legislature for confirmation on the EPA Board. I've been there, I believe five (5) years, and I didn't know time escapes. I retired as financial advisor after about thirty (30) plus years, but I'm serving on the EPA Board not in that capacity, I guess I try to bring common sense to it, and work through the different projects. As you know, most of the funding, practically all the funding is from federal funds. The staff is excellent, under staffed; they definitely need a few more positions, particularly a chief engineer position. Unfortunately, the pay is not competitive with what the private sector offers, but the Board tries to work through the different problems, oversee and make sure that a lot of the programs are brought into alignment with the US EPA. There are a couple more issues that we can work on, obviously. I'm just asking for your support.

Chairman Respicio

Thank you. This is one of the most difficult Boards to serve in because you deal with "Notice of Violations," compliance of federal grants and all of those regulatory issues. This is your third time here and hopefully your experiences here have been good. Having said that, your confirmation has been publicly heard and if there are no comments or concerns from my colleagues, then our committee members will certainly look forward to moving forward on confirming you. This just satisfies the public hearing requirement and there was no one who signed up to testify regarding your appointment. Also, your Administrator submitted written testimony.

Mr. Gregory Perez offered to provide oral testimony in support of Mrs. Roth. Chairman Respicio invited Mr. Perez to testify and noted he would include his name in the sign-in sheet.

Mr. Gregory Perez

I've known Ms. Roth while she was at the Bank of Guam. I know her to be a professional and I'm sure she'll carry that work ethic and planning and process into the EPA for everybody's benefit. And if I may, being in a matrilineal society, I'm sure that all our aunts will be consulted in everything. All of the women who have been our guiding light over the years have a say: we're going to take that, we're going to collect that. Thank you.

Chairman Respicio thanked the panel for testifying and the senators present at the hearing.


