#### II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Vice Speaker Benjamin J.F. Cruz, Chairman of the Committee on Appropriations and Adjudication ("Committee"), called the Public Hearing of Resolution No. 391-33 (COR) to order. The Chairman noted that the resolution supports the *Aviation Innovation Reform and Reauthorization Act of 2016* for its inclusion of the Airline Worker Assault Amendment: "Resolution No. 391-33 (COR): Relative to expressing I Liheslaturan Guahan's unequivocal support of H.R. (House Resolution) 4441, cited as the *Aviation Innovation Reform and Reauthorization Act of 2016*, for its inclusion of the Airline Worker assault amendment as proffered by the Honorable Congressman John R. Garamendi to make assault against airline customer service agents a felony and to further urging members of the United States Congress to seek H.R. 4441's passage.

"This resolution was introduced at the request of our local workers who are the front-line. They're the ones who meet the irate customers when their plane has been delayed for the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) or fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) time or the flight has been canceled. And as I understand that, under 49 U.S. Code, Section 46504, it's already a felony to assault flight crew members. And I think we saw that recently with that one passenger that was irate on that [Korean Air Line] flight. My understanding is that unfortunately those of you at the ticket counter and the mechanics—the ground crew are not covered and so there was an amendment that was introduced and this resolution is to try to show this Legislature's support for your recommendation or at least your request to have you all included or at least not be left out, I think not so much included as to be left out, since [the] flight crew is already taken care of.

"And for the record as I understand it, the President of your Union, Ms. Sugiyama, Sharon has sent a letter in support of the Resolution and so I [also] want to thank Senator Tom Ada for joining me this afternoon and to give the three of you an opportunity to provide any testimony. I have signed up to give testimony Ms. Yvonne Terlaje, Mr. Peter Atoigue, and Ms. Annalyn Atoigue. So why don't you go ahead and start."

**Ms. Yvonne Terlaje** then inquired if she could first read Ms. Sugiyama's written testimony (*appended to this report*), to which the Chairman Cruz agreed:

"This is a letter from Sharon Sugiyama, our local President and Vice-President of overall Guam IAMAW."

"I would like to thank Vice Speaker B.J. Cruz and his colleges for their support of this Bill. I have been working in the Airline Industry for twenty-four (24) years, I've seen it all especially since the merger of Continental Airlines and United [Airlines]. Working here in a small station compared to the hubs in the [U.S.] mainland, I have to say that we do have customers that become aggressive, abusive, physical, and more when they find out that their flight has been cancelled, delayed, or overbooked. There are customers that no matter how many times you explain the situation to them, they just don't understand. The more we explain to them, they become frustrated, demanding, using profanity, etcetera. On several occasions we had to call Airport Police and have them visible and present to prevent a riot. There [has] been incidence[s] where customer service agents were terminated because a customer grabbed him and he retaliated. It's about time we have protection for thousands of customer service agents across the nation as they do with the flight attendants and pilots. Signed, Sharon Sugiyama."

**Chairman Cruz** thanked Ms. Terlaje for presenting Ms. Sugiyama's testimony and inquired if she had any testimony of her own.

## Ms. Terlaje replied:

"I just have a story that I went through when I first started with Continental."

#### **Chairman Cruz**:

"Please, go ahead."

# Ms. Terlaje:

"This was back in 1993 and I was brand new; the first week on the job; I was shadowing a Senior Agent and it was eleven o'clock at night (11:00P PM), no one was around except for this one customer in line and I remember the gentlemen that I was shadowing, the Senior Agent, called him asked him if he needed help and he charged the counter and said, 'You! You're the one who lied to me told me that—,' I guess the Guam/ Honolulu flight was just getting Business-First [Class] at the time. So he was really upset that he wasn't given Business-First [Class] and this was already—I'm thinking he just came back on island so he was off for, I don't know, maybe two weeks so he was venting, and you know, so upset for two weeks, held it in and when he saw the guy that was helping me, the Senior Agent that I was shadowing, he (the customer) charged and pulled him over the counter by his tie and was getting mad at him. And then, somebody, one of the supervisors came out and separated them and I ran away because I didn't want to you know — I didn't know what was going to happen. Things like that—since then the gentlemen that I was shadowing the Senior Agent, he ended up resigning but for other reasons, but still that day I remember thinking, 'God do I really want to work

here? You know what I mean?' I was only what? Two weeks into the job at that. That's just my experience."

**Chairman Cruz** then thanked Ms. Terlaje for her story and proceeded to inquire if there would be any more testimony.

#### Ms. Annalyn Atoigue stated:

"Thank you so much for, you know, as Yvonne said and read out—Sharon's letter—but I think a lot of it has to do with customers just misunderstanding when they come in and flights are canceled or delayed especially when we have Typhoons. And so I think something like this would really help us because even just calling Airport Police, sometimes that's not good enough and so if it becomes a Bill and is enforced then it gives people the recognition that we also need to be treated with respect and so I think that's what it comes down to."

**Chairman Cruz** thanked Ms. Atoigue and prompted Ms. Topaz to begin her testimony.

#### Ms. Anna Topaz:

"Hi my name is Ana Alegre-Topaz and I'm [a] City Ticket Office Agent and I've been with United [Airlines], actually Continental Micronesia [Airlines] for over twenty (20) years. I don't have anything personal to talk about regarding this Bill. However, I have witnessed it—a Korean passenger way back then in the 90's when we had the Korean Flight and—one of my Agents were pushed and you know it's really just— and we couldn't do anything about it, you know. And we just wanted him to get on the flight and leave. It's just wrong, I think the Agents here—it starts with us really. When they get irate with our flights being canceled or delayed or you know—they focus on us first before it gets to the Flight Attendants or the Flight Crew. So we need to be protected just as much as they do."

**Chairman Cruz** thanked Ms. Topaz for her testimony. On account that there were no other individuals present to testify and no further questions from the Committee, the Chairman considered Resolution No. 391-33 (COR) as heard.

#### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

# BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAL TRES NA LIHESLATURAN

# GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, recognizing the need to enhance security and improve protection of airline workers across America, Congress passed legislation amending sections of the *Federal Aviation Act of 1958* (U.S. Public Law 272, 103rd U.S. Congress, July 5, 1994 and P.L. 56, 107th U.S. Congress, October 26, 2001), mandating significant reform for Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) personnel; and

WHEREAS, under federal law, aircrew members—such as flight deck and aircraft cabin personnel—are currently protected from assault, threats of assault, coercion, or any action that prevents a crewmember from safely fulfilling their duties (49 U.S.C. §46504). Such actions that pose a risk to either the crewmembers or passengers constitute a felony, punishable by a twenty year prison sentence and a maximum fine of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) (18 U.S.C. § 3571). Furthermore, offenders that assault crewmembers with any object deemed "a dangerous weapon" could face a life sentence (49 U.S.C. § 46504); and

WHEREAS, according to the FAA's Code of Federal Regulations (14 C.F.R. §§ 91.11, 121.580, 135.120), "unruly passengers" who engage in any disorderly conduct that causes disturbance to the performance of crewmembers—such as obstructing the aisles, or refusing to stay seated, comply with electronic device policies, or follow any directive issued by a flight attendant—may face a fine of up to twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000) per violation, depending on the severity of the offense (49 U.S.C. § 46318); and

**WHEREAS,** despite its legislative intent to promote the safety of passengers and airline workers, the *Federal Aviation Act* currently does not extend the same protection to its airline customer service representatives, such as gate and ticket agents, who assist customers with purchasing tickets, checking in, and boarding the aircraft; and

WHEREAS, as the frontline staff to all potential passengers, customer service agents are essential to the daily operation of every airline industry, ensuring safe and efficient boarding procedures and determining whether individuals may pose a threat to the aircraft and its passengers; and

WHEREAS, the exclusion of customer service representatives from federal protection unduly burdens agents who consistently interact with disorderly customers. Due to this exclusion, customer service agents are denied the protection needed when handling potential assailants. As a result, violence directed at customer service agents often goes unreported, with most assailants permitted to board the aircraft; and

WHEREAS, a recent example of such appalling attacks against customer service agents occurred at the Ft. Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport in January 2014 during which an individual physically assaulted a defenseless United Airlines ticket agent, leaving the agent with "bruises and swelling to her face and head"; and

WHEREAS, although the assailant was subsequently arrested and charged 1 with battery, the lack of uniform enforcement in cases of assault against customer 2 service agents signifies that such actions are subject to the arbitrary decision of 3 local authorities, resulting in most cases remaining unprosecuted; and 4 WHEREAS, in response to these injustices, the International Association of 5 Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAMAW) partnered with members from the 6 7 transportation division of the American Federation of Labor and Congress of Industrial Organizations (AFL-CIO) to push for the inclusion of language 8 protecting airline customer service agents in the Federal Aviation Act; and 9 WHEREAS, on February 3, 2016, Congressman William F. Shuster, U.S. 10 Representative for Pennsylvania's Ninth (9th) District, introduced H.R. 4441, cited 11 as the Aviation Innovation, Reform, and Reauthorization Act of 2016, to 12 reauthorize the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) through Fiscal Year 2019; 13 14 and WHEREAS, recognizing the need to include language to protect all airline 15 16 workers, Congressman John Garamendi, U.S. Representative for California's 3rd District, proffered an amendment to make assault on airline customer service 17 representatives a felony. The Garamendi Amendment—also known as the Airline 18 Worker Assault Amendment—was unanimously adopted by the U.S. House 19 Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure during the Committee's 20 Consideration and Markup Session on February 11, 2016; and 21 22 23

WHEREAS, to demonstrate support of the amendment, officers of Local Lodge 2339G, IAMAW representatives at United Airlines in Guam, collected over two hundred (200) signatures expressing solidarity with all airline workers—including those employed in customer service, ramp service, city ticket offices, and stores—and further urging the passage of H.R. 4441 in U.S. Congress; and

# **Supports**

H.R. 4441, a federal measure to grant airline customer service agents the same protection currently provided to crewmembers.

# **Backstory**:

Resolution was introduced in response to the outpouring of signatures (224) collected by the Guam division of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAMAW) union who pushed for inclusive language.

IAMAW pointed out that federal law only considers it a felony to assault flight crew members (49 U.S. Code §46504).

This leaves cases of assault against customer service representatives, such as gate and ticket agents to local authorities.

This is a problem because customer service agents are the front line staff for all passengers.

# Mechanics:

H.R. 4441 would remedy this exclusion by adding airline customer service representatives to the federal statute, making assault against such workers a felony.
