The Bureau requests that Bill No. 202-35 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill 202-35 (COR) is an act to add a new item (t) to §8104 of Chapter 8, Title 5A, Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations relative to authorizing additional exemptions for teacher certification for former professors. The proposed amendment would exempt individuals who possess a terminal degree and have at least two (2) years of documented an verifiable teaching experience at any United States accredited college or university from being required to take an examination of general knowledge, specialization or content area knowledge, and pedagogical knowledge.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
