1/ The proposed legislation intends to amend Section 1(w), Chapter 5 of Public Law 35-36 relative to the Guam Customs and Quarantine Agency (CQA) FY2020 appropriation section. The Legislation, if passed, would authorize the continuing appropriation of CQAs Fiscal Year 2019 unexpended balance until fully expended. Recent projections indicate that CQA is projected to lapse approximately \$269,340.60. However, based on the August 31, 2019 Special Revenue Fund Tracking Report, CQA is projected to fall short of the FY2019 adopted level of \$14,378,999. Therefore, if this legislation were to pass the balance for carryover into FY2020 would be approximately \$8,441.60.
