Håfa Adai! Senator Biscoe-Lee:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 84-35 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

The proposed legislation is an act to amend Article 9 of Chapter 3, Title 16 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to extending the Plug-In Electric Vehicle Rebate Program to private businesses and non-profit organizations, whereas currently it is only offered to individuals in an effort to incentivize those who are contributing positively to our environment by choosing to purchase zero-emission vehicles. Additionally, the Amendment proposes to extend the rebate phase-out period to allow for more time for the program. Furthermore, the Bill intends to add and adopt a new Chapter 2 to Title 7 of the Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations to implement the same.

The proposed amendments are administrative in nature and would not fiscally impact the appropriations of the government of Guam.
