Introduced by F. R. Santos

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11017 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO RENAME THE YONA ELEMENTARY
SCHOOL THE MANUEL U. LUJAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11017 is hereby added to the
Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11017. Manuel U. Lujan Elementary School.
The elementary school located in the municipality of
Yona and heretofore known as the 'Yona Elementary School
is hereby renamed the 'Manuel U. Lujan Elementary School'
and such ceremony as the Director deems appropriate,
said school shall be officially named.
