
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

This is to certify that Bill Number 68, "An Act to adopt a Territorial Hymn for Guam", was on the 17th day of April, 1952, duly and regularly passed.







An Act to adopt a Territorial Hymn
for Guam.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The composition consisting of the words and music known as the Guam Hymn, composed by R. M. Sablan, is designated the territorial hymn of the territory of Guam.

Section 2. The words and music of the Guam Hymn referred to in the preceding section, are as herein below set forth.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure and shall become effective upon the date of its approval by the Governor.
