1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

1       Section 1 Legislative findings. The Legislature finds that the  
2 Manengon Bridge in Yona is extensively corroded and is unsafe for use by  
3 heavy vehicles. The Legislature further finds that the current bridge cannot  
4 be adequately repaired but is the only means of access to the rest of Guam for  
5 the many residents of the area.

6       Section 2. Appropriation. One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars  
7 (\$1,200,000) are hereby appropriated from the Fiscal Year 1991 revenues of  
8 the General Fund to the Department of Public Works to replace the Manengon  
9 Bridge in Yona.

10       Section 3. Pursuant to Section 4, Subsection (b) of Public Law 20-29,  
11 One Hundred Two Thousand Dollars (\$102,000) are hereby appropriated from  
12 the General Fund to the Micronesian Area Research Center of the University  
13 of Guam to complete the second year of the project of analyzing the human  
14 remains, artifacts and relics discovered at Gongga Beach and in Agana.

## **COMMITTEE REPORT**

### **BILL NO. 268**

#### **AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$750,000) TO REPLACE THE MANENGON BRIDGE IN YONA.**

A public hearing was conducted by the Committee on Ways and Means on Friday, May 5, 1989, beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Legislative Session Hall to hear testimony on Bill No. 268. Committee Chairman, Senator Carl T.C. Gutierrez, conducted the hearing, being joined by Senators Ted S. Nelson, Martha C. Ruth, Franklin J. Quitugua, Doris F. Brooks and J. George M. Bamba.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Bill No. 268 would appropriate Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of replacing the Manengon Bridge.

#### **TESTIMONY**

Mr. Vicente Bernardo, Mayor of the Village of Yona, appearing at the hearing on behalf of the Municipal Planning Council and the residents of Yona, gave an oral testimony in full support of Bill No. 268.

#### **ANALYSIS**

The appropriation of One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000) would be sufficient for the replacement of the Manengon Bridge as evidenced by the Fiscal Note submitted by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research attached hereto.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

The Committee on Ways & Means recommends that Bill No. 268 be Substituted and Passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature.
