Section 1. Legislative Intent. Governor Ricardo J. Bordallo by his letter on March 23, 1983 to the Speaker of the Legislature transmitted for approval by the Legislature the transfer of certain public lands to the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority. The land parcels in question are not needed for any public purposes other than those in connection with the Sinajana

Section 2. The Legislature, pursuant to the provisions of Section 6, Public Law 15-13, approves the transfer of the following public lands to the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority:

- (a) Lot No. 3045-1-3 (Part of Basic Lot 3045-1 Rem), Sinajana, containing an area of 98.71 square meters;
- (b) Lot No. 3045-3-2 (Part of Basic Lot 3045-3) Sinajana, containing an area of 53.37 square meters; and
- (c) Lot No. 3048-4-3 (Part of Basic Lot 3048-4), Sinajana, containing an area of 26.99 square meters.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairperson Senator Gordon Mailloux.

WITNESSES PRESENT: Mr. Ricardo A. Calvo, Deputy Director, Guam Housing & Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA).

SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES

The Deputy Director of GHURA submitted testimony in support of Bill No. 1027.

He offered that the Bill addresses the property situated within the Sinajana Urban Renewal Project and were inadvertently omitted from previous transfer to GHURA. The three parcels are needed to consolidate the Basic Lot 3045-4 to form the new designation Lot 24, Block 18, Tract 232, as per the approved Sinajana Urban Renewal Land Disposition Plan.

Senator Mailloux asked Mr. Calvo to explain the situation with Mr. John Bostrom, a property owner within the area in question. Is there any land taken from Mr. Bostrom, and would there be any difficulties negotiating with him?

Mr. Calvo explained that Part of the property and house was acquired by the government due to the expansion of Senator Gibson Drive. The three parcels are needed to conform with the existing lot designation. Once the Legislature approves this Bill, land transfer will be made to GHURA, who will execute the sale to Mr. Bostrom. Mr. Bostrom intends to comply with the Urban Renewal Plan. Upon approval of the Bill, no legislative approval thereafter is necessary.

FINDINGS/RECOMMENDATIONS

The content of Bill 1027 was first entertained as Resolution No. 53. As advised by Legislative Council and sponsor of the Bill, Resolution No. 53 is reintroduced in a Bill form, known as Bill No. 1027. Documents gathered and appended to the report on Resolution No. 53 are attached to this report.

Bill No. 1027 proposes to transfer government land, situated within the Sinajana Urban Renewal Project, to Guam Housing

and Urban Renewal Authority. The properties are more particularly described as Lot Nos. 3045-1-3, 3045-3-2, and 3048-4-3. The above are remnants of Basic Lots 3045-1-REM, 3045-3, and 3048-4, Sinajana, acquired by the Government of Guam through eminent domain process under Civil Case No. The total area of the three lots amounts to 179.09 46-67. square meters. The three parcels are needed to consolidate basic Lot 3045-4 to form the new lot designation Lot 24, Block 18, Tract 232, identified in the approved Sinajana Urban Renewal Land Disposition Plan. These lots were inadvertently omitted from previous requests for transfer of Government of Guam land to GHURA. Before the Governor can execute the Grant Deed effecting the transfer, Legislative approval must first be given pursuant to Section 6 of Public Law 15-131.

The Committee finds the transfer of these parcels to GHURA necessary to comply with the approved Sinajana Urban Renewal Land Disposition Plan. The Committee, hereby, recommends Bill No. 1027 to pass by the Twentieth Guam Legislature.

Gentlemen:

On this date, field survey work has been completed, staking out six (6) boundary points in accordance with Doc. 86453 Sheet 14 of 18, Property Line Map, Sinajana Project Guam R-2(a) dated February 1968. Under this document, Lot 3045-4 is shown containing an area of 9,426 square feet. For your information, based on Doc. 86453, our computed area for subject lot is 9,372.4 square feet, more or less.

Under Doc. 118654 recorded on Dec. 5, 1972, Declaration of Taking, Guam Housing & Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) took a portion of Lot 3045-4 belonging to Melvin E. Wirick totalling 1,255 square feet from 9,426 square feet leaving Lot 3045-4 to contain 8,171 square feet. However, new bearings or distances were not indicated on the attached xerox copy of the lot as an exhibit of Doc. 118654.

We spoke with Mr. Nick Borja of GHURA with regard to the missing bearings and distances of Lot 3045-4 as shown on Doc. 118654 and he says that he does not have the mathematical information on his files. Esco International determined the area and prepared the calculations, but the company is no longer doing business on Guam.

Because we are unable to obtain the necessary backup information concerning the legal area of Lot 3045-4 which is 8,171 square feet, we have relocated the boundary points based on Doc. 86453 showing an area of 9,426 square feet. Boundary corners behind the concrete house are marked with a rebar with fluorescent flagging ribbon and 3 remaining corners are marked with concrete nails on the asphalt concrete pavement with yellow cap marked "RLS#62".

Furthermore, according to Mr. Borja, GHURA filed a request to purchase from the Government of Guam (owner of adjacent property) additional land of 2,070 square feet to be added to Lot 3045-4. At the time the request was filed, cost of the additional land was approximately \$400.00+. However, this purchase requires legislative approval. Mr. Borja

informed us that this request was filed about 6 to 7 years ago and his office has been following up on this matter, but no action has been taken by the Guam Legislature. If land purchase was approved by the Guam Legislature and transaction consummated, the new area.for Lot 3045-4 will be 10,241.00 square feet.





On this date, field survey work has been completed, staking out six (6) boundary points in accordance with Doc. 86453 Sheet 14 of 18, Property Line Map, Sinajana Project Guam R-2(a) dated February 1968. Under this document, Lot 3045-4 is shown containing an area of 9,426 square feet. For your information, based on Doc. 86453, our computed area for subject lot is 9,372.4 square feet, more or less.

Under Doc. 118654 recorded on Dec. 5, 1972, Declaration of Taking, Guam Housing & Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) took a portion of Lot 3045-4 belonging to Melvin E. Wirick totalling 1,255 square feet from 9,426 square feet leaving Lot 3045-4 to contain 8,171 square feet. However, new bearings or distances were not indicated on the attached xerox copy of the lot as an exhibit of Doc. 118654.

We spoke with Mr. Nick Borja of GHURA with regard to the missing bearings and distances of Lot 3045-4 as shown on Doc. 118654 and he says that he does not have the mathematical information on his files. Esco International determined the area and prepared the calculations, but the company is no longer doing business on Guam.

Because we are unable to obtain the necessary backup information concerning the legal area of Lot 3045-4 which is 8,171 square feet, we have relocated the boundary points based on Doc. 86453 showing an area of 9,426 square feet. Boundary corners behind the concrete house are marked with a rebar with fluorescent flagging ribbon and 3 remaining corners are marked with concrete nails on the asphalt concrete pavement with yellow cap marked "RLS#62".

Furthermore, according to Mr. Borja, GHURA filed a request to purchase from the Government of Guam (owner of adjacent property) additional land of 2,070 square feet to be added to Lot 3045-4. At the time the request was filed, cost of the additional land was approximately \$400.00+. However, this purchase requires legislative approval. Mr. Borja

informed us that this request was filed about 6 to 7 years ago and his office has been following up on this matter, but no action has been taken by the Guam Legislature. purchase was approved by the Guam Legislature and transaction consummated, the new area for Lot 3045-4 will be 10,241.00 square feet.

Former Governor Ricardo J. Bordallo by his letter on March 23, 1983 to the Speaker of the Legislature transmitted for approval by the Legislature the transfer of certain public lands to the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority.
