COMMITTEE REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS ON BILL NO. 810

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION FUND.

PREFACE

A public hearing on Bill No. 810 was held by the Committee on Ways and Means on Thursday, July 20, 1989, at the Legislative session hall.

Present at the hearing were Chairperson Senator Carl Gutierrez, and Senators Ted Nelson and Elizabeth Arriola.

BACKGROUND

Bill No. 810 is an act appropriating the sum of \$400,000 from the General Fund to the Workmen's Compensation Fund. In the past, the Legislature has appropriated certain sums of money to the Workmen's Compensation Fund of the Department of Labor. The appropriation by the Legislature is an annual appropriation for compensating government workers who unfortunately encounter physical or mental injury while on the job.

The appropriation request of \$400,000 is in the governor's budget request for fiscal year 1990. The appropriation will be utilized to cover all claims under the categories of physical disabilities, fatality, and medical services rendered.

TESTIMONIES

Two individuals testified for Bill No. 810, Mr. Christian L. Delfin and Mr. Michael Reidy. Mr. Christian Delfin is the Employment Program Administrator for the Worker's Compensation Commission at the Department of Labor. Mr. Delfin submitted a written testimony on behalf of then Acting Director of the Department of Labor, Mr. J. M. Taijito. The testimony was in favor of the appropriation of the sum of \$400,000 to the Workmen's Compensation Fund, which also included information concerning past fiscal appropriations and allocations of

funds in addition to information on outstanding and pending payments to recipients.

Mr. Michael Reidy testified in favor of Bill No. 810, and stated that the requested appropriation is included in the Governor's Fiscal Budget for 1990.

Following the testimonies by Mr. Delfin and Mr. Reidy, questions were asked by the sitting committee members Senators Carl Gutierrez, Ted Nelson, and Elizabeth Arriola concerning the appropriation and the amount of claims pending. The senators also questioned whether the appropriation of \$400,000 was sufficient to cover all pending claims and potential claims for the upcoming year.

FINDINGS

It has been brought to the attention of the Committee on Ways and Means that the requested appropriation sum of \$400,000 from the General Fund to the Workmen's Compensation Fund is included in the Governor's 1990 Fiscal Budget. If the appropriation being requested is not adequate to cover the claims, further requests from the legislature will be made.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Ways and Means to which was referred Bill No. 810 "AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION FUND" has had the same under consideration, and now wishes to report back with the recommendation TO DO PASS.






