I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Community, Housing and Cultural Affairs conducted a public hearing on October 27, 1995 at 10:00 AM at the Public Hearing Room, Temporary Guam Legislature Building, 155 Hesler Street, Agana, to receive public input on Bill No. 308. Public notice was given in the Pacific Daily News on October 25, 1995.

II. SUMMARY OF THE HEARING

No one appeared to testify on the bill.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

Bill No. 308 is a measure to make two technical corrections in §60515 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, enacted in Public Law 23-31. The first change is to properly identify Guam's 1963 land survey system as the "triangulation" system and the second change is to ensure that its replacement, the 1993 Guam Geodetic Network, follows the control standards prescribed in the Federal Geodetic Control Committee's publication, Geometric Geodetic Accuracy Standards and Specification for Using GPS Relative Positioning Techniques, Version 5.0 (Reprinted 1 August 1989) and as updated as necessary. While seemingly minor, the changes are important to the successful operation of the 1993 system.

Accordingly, the Committee on Community, Housing and Cultural Affairs, to which was referred **Bill No. 308**, submits its findings and recommendation to the Twenty-Third Guam Legislature to "DO PASS" this measure. The Committee further recommends that the Bill be included on the agenda of the next legislative session for passage into law.

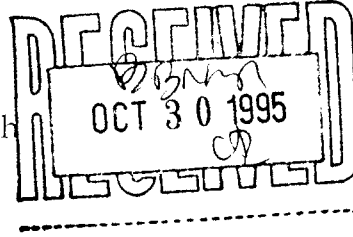

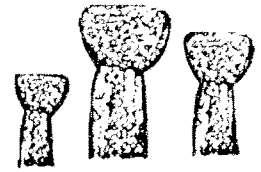
