Dear Speaker Unpingco:

Enclosed please find a copy of Bill No. 488 (LS), "AN ACT TO PROVIDE SUPPLEMENTAL ASSISTANCE TO THOSE COMMERCIAL FARMERS WHO SUFFERED DAMAGE AS A RESULT OF SUPERTYPHOON PAKA", which I have signed into law today as Public Law No. 24-121.

This legislation provides an additional \$250,000, added to the previous \$250,000 made available by Executive Order No. 97-39 to enable Guam farmers to get back on their feet after the ravages of Supertyphoon Paka on December 16, 1997.

The farmers who would be eligible for this additional subsidy are those who are certified and who received some compensation under Executive Order No. 97-39.

This legislation provides for \$5,000 loans for farmers from any surplus of this appropriation. The surplus, if any, is directed to be placed into the "Fisherman and Farmers Revolving Fund". There is no such "Fisherman and Farmers Revolving Fund", however, there is a "Farmers Small Loan Revolving Fund" now codified in §60301 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, and which was established in Section 12010 of the Government Code by Public Law No. 11-119. The Legislature should correct the fund name in order to allow the surplus to be placed in a fund where the farmers will have access to the intended loans.
