BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guahan* finds that the repairs and renovation on the building housing the office of the Mayor of *Hagåtña* was started several years ago, but, because of the lack of funding and other problems, the renovation and repairs were never completed.

It has been several years since the repairs and renovation were started and I Liheslaturan Guahan intends to complete this vitally needed project so that the community of Hagåtña and the office of its Mayor can have a more modern and safe facility to operate more efficiently, especially more so since Hagåtña is the capitol city of Guam.

Section 2. Appropriation. Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works to complete the repairs and renovations of the *Hagåtña* Mayor's office.

Committee Report

Bill No. 664(COR)

"An Act to appropriate Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00) from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works for completion of renovation and repairs of Hagatna mayor's office".

I. OVERVIEW:

The Committee on Finance and Taxation held a public hearing on Wednesday, July 8, 1998 at 2:00 p.m. in the legislative public hearing room to hear public testimony on *Bill No. 664 (COR)*. Pursuant to the requirements of Public Law 24-109, a reminder memorandum was sent on Monday, June 22, 1998. Additionally, a public hearing notice was published in the Pacific Daily News on Thursday, July 2, 1998 and on Tuesday, July 7, 1998.

III. BACKGROUND:

Findings:

Bill 664(COR) will fund much needed and long delayed renovation and repairs of the Hagatna Mayor's office. The project called for is reasonable and justified for the seat of municipal government and the capital of Guam. An appropriation of \$80,000.00 is fair and nominal.

SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES:

The mayors of Hagatna and Mangilao testified in strong support of the Bill.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

The Committee, having conducted a sufficient hearing, recommends the passage of Bill 664(COR) as substituted.

TESTIMONY ON BILL 664

Dear Mr. Chairman:

On behalf of the people of Hagatna, I wish to take this opportunity to thank the Sponsor of the much needed bill no. 664, appropriating \$80,000.00 to fund the completion of the Hagatna Mayor's Office.

For over five years now, several attempts were made to undertake this project, but somehow, it manages to find itself lost in the shuffle over other projects. This is unfortunate because Hagatna is the Capitol of our island, yet, the seat of the local (municipal) government continues to appear like a park toilet, often mistaken as one by tourists.

When Typhoon Paka hit, My office leaked all over damaging some of our equipment. The roof has to be replaced by concrete roofing and generally make the building more secure. In the long run, this investment will pay off. The amount of \$80,000.00 is modest, but adequate to accomplish the most basic purpose.

Mr. Chairman, and Members, I urge the passage of this bill so that we can reflect a greater pride in the symbol of government authority, and provide greater security to public property.
