The Committee on Utilities and Land, to which was referred Bill 397 (COR), "AN ACT TO REZONE LOT NO. 141-1-2-1, MUNICIPALITY OF AGAT, FROM MULTIPLE DWELLING ZONE (R2) TO COMMERCIAL (C) ZONE," conducted a public hearing on Tuesday, December 7, 2004, at the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room. Speaker vicente (ben) c. pangelinan conducted the legislative hearing as Chairman on Utilities and Land. Also in attendance was Senator Robert Klitzkie.

Summary

Mr. Fred Castro, representing the Guam Environmental Protection Agency, registered the agency's objection to this bill, which is to spot rezone a single property. Mr. Fred Castro explained that the government already has a working process to rezone property. By legislatively rezoning a single lot, it decreases the quality of life for the surrounding community. Examples of problems caused by spot rezoning includes decrease in public water pressure, contamination of water well, traffic safety risks, inadequate parking, devaluation of neighboring properties, among others. He said that the process of spot rezoning would lead to increased deficiencies in infrastructure and public services, damage to natural resources, degradation of the environment and overall lowering the quality of life and loss of potential economic development.

Mr. Fred Castro also explained that the particular lot being rezoned by this bill, although Guam EPA is not provided the information needed to advise the owner, which would be provided through the Guam Land Use Commission process, may be able to use the lot for certain rezoned commercial uses, although limited by the size of the lot and by flood zone restrictions.

Mr. Cel Babauta, owner of the property being rezoned, testified in favor of the bill. He believes that by getting the property rezoned to Commercial, to be used as a "Mom & Pop" store, it will help pay for his children's college education expenses, including their loans. In addition, he is also committing a portion of the store's income to donate to the youth of Agat. Mr. Cel Babauta and his family plan to provide financial contribution that will help procure baseballs, bats, uniforms and many other sports necessities for the

youths of Agat. By getting the property rezoned to Commercial, he said that his family would contribute to the tax base of the government of Guam.

Chairman and Speaker ben pangelinan asked if there is already a structure in the property. Mr. Cel Babauta informed him that there is.

Sen. Bob Klitzkie asked Mr. Cel Babauta what happened when he went to the Land Use Commission process. Mr. Cel Babauta informed him that his neighbors are not opposed to the rezoning request. When he went to the Department of Land Management, he was told that because of his eagerness to rezone, he should go to the Legislature for a faster result. He approached DLM again, this time, he spoke with employees in-charge more on the details of rezoning, and he was told to see consultants. Mr. Cel Babauta does not have the money to pay for such consulting services. It is not his intent to circumvent the regular process, but because he was advised to seek the Legislature's assistance, that's what he did.

HEARING ON **BILL 397**: AN ACT TO REZONE LOT NO 141-1-2-1, MUNICIPALITY OF AGAT FROM MULTIPLE DWELLING ZONE (R2) TO COMMERCIAL (C)

December 7, 2004

Buenas yan Saluda, Mr. Chairman and Committee Members. I am pleased to have the opportunity this morning to provide for you some critical information in response to your invitation to testify on Bill 397.

Bill 397 proposes to spot zone a single property in Agat from R-2, currently allowing Multiple Family Dwellings, to C, which allows commercial developments.

The existing land zoning system on Guam was instituted in 1966, by Guam's first Land Use Plan. This legal control on uses of land was a valuable innovation to improve the quality of our life, support development and protect our environment. But, as development, population and infrastructure grew since that time, the old zoning maps have become inappropriate and obsolete in most areas. Over the last thirty-eight years, various attempts have been made to update Guam's Land Use Plan and associated Zoning Code. The greatest effort, spurred by the Guam Comprehensive Planning Law, Public Law 20-147, resulted in the I Tano'-ta Land Use Plan and Zoning Code. This Island-wide comprehensive revision became Public Law 24-171 in 1998, but was only implemented for a month in 1999, when it was withdrawn by the Legislature for amendments, which were never made. Therefore, by the unfortunate continuation of the old zoning, developers and land owners remain disadvantaged and need to seek changes to their old zoning designations.

Mr. Chairman, you and I were active members of the Guam Planning Council which was responsible for the drafting and approval of I Tano'-ta. We learned and strongly supported the value of comprehensive land use planning as we adopted a plan and zoning code based on meeting the needs expressed by the public at the

over one hundred public hearings we held on I Tano'-ta. We even designated and had approved a specific zone for this lot and adjacent properties that was compatible with infrastructure, with surrounding use potentials and with the environment, while allowing gainful economic development.

Guam Planning Council also prioritized the need for water infrastructure master planning. The Guam Waterworks Authority is currently developing a Master Plan for water and sewer facilities that will address current problems and comprehensively meet needs for Guam's future. This Plan, costing over five million dollars, will be eroded and lose its value if spot zoning of properties occurs.

In lieu of a revised zoning code, a mechanism exists for owners to change zones of their properties. This involves applying for a zone change to the Guam Land Use Commission. Staff of the Department of Land Management assist applicants in obtaining requested zone changes and offer professional advice on best procedures to take. This zone change process allows for review and comments by technical staff of the Government as well as notification in writing to neighboring property owners who will be impacted by the zone change and public hearings in the village where the property is located, as well as review by the Mayor and Planning Council

of the village. Adequacy of infrastructure to support the uses allowed in the new zone, conformity with neighboring uses and with sectoral master plans, and concerns of impacted neighbors are all addressed. Many of the safeguards of this process are absent when properties are spot zoned through the legislative process, actually leading to more problems for the owner and decrease in the quality of life for the surrounding community.

If one individual zone change is passed through this proposed spot zoning law, thousands of other owners should also expect to be able to change their zoning through this poorly controlled process. This would lead to increased deficiencies in infrastructure and public services, damage to natural resources, degradation of the environment and overall lowering of the quality of life and loss of potential economic development.

Therefore, we generally oppose the provision of zone changes for individual properties through this legislative process and recommend that this property be directed to the Guam Land Use Commission for rezoning.

We further recommend that the Guam Legislature support new efforts to develop an

updated and revised Land Use Plan and Zoning Code for the Island.

In the case of this particular lot, although we are not provided the information needed to advise the owner, which would be provided through the Guam Land Use Commission process, we believe the owner of the property may be able to use the lot for certain rezoned commercial uses, although limited by the size of the lot and by flood zone restrictions.

Thank you for the opportunity to provide this testimony, which we hope will help you reach the best decision in acting on this bill.

FRED M. CASTRO

Good-morning Mr. Speaker, Honorable Members of the Committee, and the 27th Guam Legislature,

My family and I would like to express our sincere gratitude for allowing me the opportunity to testify in support of Bill which would re-zone Lot 141-1-2-1, located in the municipality of Agat. Although the lot is only 683 square meters, re-zoning the property would contribute to the island and the community. It is the hope of my wife, Virginia, and I that one day we would maximize the usage of the property to pay for the education and training of our four children.

Initially, we believe that by having the property zoned commercial, it would benefit the island. Because it is located along Marine Corps Drive, our plan is to open a family business that is focused on serving the people of Merizo, Umatac, Agat, Santa Rita, and certainly others who journey to the southern part of Guam. At Mangilao, there is the Taro Hut and in Agana, there is the Agana Liquor Store. These two business entities afford customers mainly with local food for those on their way to work, school, family gatherings, and for family members abroad. Our goal is to open a store that is similar to the Taro Hut and the Agana Liquor Store. Creating a store of this nature would serve hundreds of workers, students, and residents of the south who are in need of something to eat for breakfast, lunch, and of course for snacks, and parties. Moreover, we would employ, hope to profit, and in the end, contribute to the tax base of the government of Guam.

How will this business help the village of Agat? Upon my retirement from the United States Air Force and at the time recently coached a team from Germany at the Little

League World Series at Kissimmee, Florida in 1991, I returned to Guam to live and support the community. One of the first volunteer work I did was coached the Babe Ruth 16-18 year old youngsters who play for the village of Agat. The players I had at the time were Tommy Morrison, Derek Santos, Rico Castro, Dominic Cruz, Steve Aguon, and other fine youngsters. A tremendous challenge I encountered was financial support to purchase baseballs, bats, uniforms, etc. Though Mayor Tony Babauta and other local leaders assisted financially, it was rather taxing to solicit and obtain all the resources that we need for the players. Mr. Speaker and members of this legislature, I can assure you that the business that surfaces at this property will contribute to the youth of Agat. We will provide financial contribution that will help procure baseballs, bats, uniforms, etc. for the players.

When Virginia and I bought the property in 1988, our wish was to use whatever financial income that we make on the property to pay for the education of our children - Mona, Chris, Marie, and John. The eldest being Mona, followed by Chris, then Marie, and finally John. Mona completed an undergraduate degree from University of Notre Dame at South Bend, Indiana and later graduated from Syracuse University at New York with a Masters Degree in Public Policy. Chris completed a telecommunications program at Santa Clara University in California, and Marie graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in Psychology from University of Maryland. John is currently a high school student at Father Duenas. Being that Virginia stayed home and took care of the kids, I am the only one who provides for the family. As a result, we still owe thousands of dollars in college loans that we are presently paying in order for our children to have a decent education. With the assistance of this legislature in rezoning our property to

commercial, we will open the business and utilize part of the income to help pay for the college bills that we are obligated to meet.

Mr. Speaker, Committee Members, and the legislature as a whole, Virginia, our kids, and I humbly seek your support in the passage of this bill. We are not a well to do family but rather a family that belief in serving our nation, our island, and our village community. Give us your support in rezoning our property and this noble government entity can be assured that a portion of the profit we earn will be dedicated towards helping our youths – the most valuable resources of this territory. We will contribute to the health, education, and public safety in the form of tax contributions. Si yo'us ma'ase and thanks so much for the opportunity to come before all of you.



Body of Ebersol's son | Brewers finish deal recovered in wreckage

MONTROSE, Colo. (AP) -- Moments after surviving a hornific plane crash, Charles Ebersol frantically begged bystanders for help in rescuing his kid brother from the wreckage: 'Can you please help get him out? the 21-year-old was quoted as saying.

Nearby, his father, NBC Sports chairman Dick Ebersol, sat on the snowy ground amid the billowing smoke and chunks of wreckage, numbly rocking back and forth, according to a witness.

"You could tell he was in shock. Both of them had been ripped out of their shoes," said Doug Percival, a driver at a towing service who was one of the first to arrive.

The account came a day after a jet carrying the Ebersols crashed during a snowstorm v hile taking off from the airport outside this small fown 185 miles southwest of Denver. Authorities said Monday they had removed a body from the wreckage matching that of 14-year-old Edward "Teddy Ebersol, a freshman at a Connecticut boarding school.

Two crewmen also died and another was injured along with the two Ebersols. NBC said in a statement Monday that Dick and Charlie Ebersol are in stable condition and expected to make a full recovery.

Authorities had no immediate word on the cause of the crash.

With light snow falling, crews began picking through the charred pile of twisted metal and a 6-foot-high shard of the fuselage with three gaping, round windows. The two engines lay on the ground nearby near the tail section where they had been mounted.

A backhoe was brought in to help dig through the wreckage, found near a cattle pen in a snow-covered field dotted with knee-high weeds. A gray tarp was draped across part of the site as crews wrapped up work for the day.

"It's going to be a while because unfortunately a lot of the wreckage is still covered with snow," said Arnold Scott, the lead investigator for the Na-

tional Transportation Safety Board. Coroner Mark Young said the body thought to be that of the youngest Ebersol was found underneath the wreckage. Heavy equipment was used to recover the body.

Dick Ebersol has been head of NBC Sports for nearly 15 years, and is perhaps best known for his love of the Olympics, which are broadcast on the network.

He and his two sons were flying home from California, where the older son's school, Notre Dame, played a football game Saturday against Southern California. Another Ebersol son, 18-year-old Willie, is a freshman at USC.

The family flew to Colorado, where they have a home, to drop off Ebersol's wife, Susan Saint James, an actress who starred in the 1980s television series "Kate and Allie." Then, Ebersol and the two sons were headed to drop off Charles at school in South Bend,

A heavy snowstorm had eased up before the plane prepared to take off, but there was no immediate word if weather was a factor. Steve McLaughlin of MTJ Air Services, which de-ices private planes at the airport, said his company did not de-ice Ebersol's plane before it took off. Airport Manager Scott Brownlee said he did not know whether the plane had been de-iced.

Witnesses said it appeared the plane, a CL-601 Challenger, never got off the ground. It ran off the runway and skidded across a two-lane road, punching through fences on either side before bursting into flames.

Miller's \$8.75 million, three-year contract was finalized by the Milwankee Brewers and Doug Mirabelli became the first of Boston's 16free agents to re-sign, agreeing to a \$3 million, two-year deal Monday.

As the free-agent market resurned following the Thanksgiving week-end break, 1

And the New York Yankees neared agreement on a contract with backup catcher John Flaherty.

Left-handed pitcher Dennys Reyes agreed to a \$550,000, onevear contract with the San Diego Padres, who last week reached an agreement with right-hander Rudy Seanez for the same amount.

While the top and middle of the market awaits the Dec. 7 deadline for teams to offer salary arbitration to their former players who became free agents, players with lower pro-

files are signing.

Miller's deal was agreed to last Tuesday, and he took a physical the following day. But the Brewers put off completing the agreement because they couldn't find any of their team physicians to read the MRI exam results ahead of the holiday weekend.

"We were getting all the information together to a level we felt comfortable with and we feel fine about it now," general manager Doug Melvin said. "It was just due diligence. We had to get a second opinion on some things.

Miller gets \$3.25 million in each of the next two seasons, and Milwaukee has a \$3.75 million option for 2007. If the Brewers decline it, Miller would get a \$2.25 million player option and the chance, if he exercises it, to earn \$750,000 more in performance bonuses

Miller, 35, grew up in La Crosse. He hit .272 with nine homers and a career-high 58 RBIs in 110 games for Oakland last season, including .324 with runners in scoring position and .412 with the bases loaded.

Mirabelli will earn a \$200,000 signing bonus and \$1.4 million in each of the next two seasons under his contract with the World Series champions. Mirabelli made \$825,000 last season, when he batted .281 with nine homers and 32 RBIs in 160 at-bats as Jason Varitek's backup and the regu-lar catcher for knuckleballer Tim Wakefield.

Bennett, 32, fulfills the need for a backup to Brian Schneider on the Expos, who will become the Nationals once baseball owners approve the proposed move. Bennett hit .224 with three home runs and 20 RBIs in 75 games for Milwankee last year. He's a career .247 hitter in nine seasons with Philadelphia, the New York Mets, Colorado, San Diego and Milwaukee.

Bennett's best season came with San Diego in 2003, when he had 42 RBIs in 96 games.

Reyes was 4-8 with a 4.75 ERA in 40 games with Kansas City last

season, including 12 starts.
Flaherty hit .252 in 127 at-bats but was the key to several New York wins, hitting six homers and driving in 16 runs. He made \$775,000 and his new deal was likely to be for a salary between that and \$1 million.

Second baseman Miguel Cairo, like Flaherty represented by agent Alan Nero, also hopes to re-sign with the Yankees.

Spurrier hires son as assistant

COLUMBIA, S.C. -University of South Carolina coach Steve Spurrier is continuing to work on filling out his staff, saying Monday he'd talked to about 20 potential candidates and had hired a fourth assistant - his son.

Steve Spurrier Jr., who has just completed his first year as the tight ends coach at Arizona, will coach wide receivers. While only 33, the younger Spurrier already owns a pair of national championship rings earned as an assistant at Oklahoma in 2000 and Florida in 1996.

With the hiring of his son, Spurrier has filled four assistants slots, with the other three coaches holdovers from Lou Holtz's staff. Also, Spurrier said he had hired Jamie Speronias as his director of football operations and Mark Smith as his strength coach.

Speronias did the same job for Spurrier at Florida, where, along with assisting Spurrier with the day-to-day opera-

tions of the program, he oversaw the walk-on program and worked with NFL scouts.

Smith was with Spurrier at Florida and the NFL's Washington Redskins, He was with the New Orleans Saints this past season.

"He's ready to go," Spurier said. "He's one of the best. He believes like I do that speed goes with strength. Strength is only 50 percent of the game, and speed is the other 50 percent as far as conditioning.

Spurrier said he was "fairly close" to filling several other spots on his nine-man staff, saying he would likely hire his defensive coordinator next and "let him have some input" on the rest of the defensive staff.

Section 1. Legislative Statement. The owner of Lot No. 141-1-2-1, located in the Municipality of Agat, containing an area of 683.46 square meters, has requested the assistance of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to rezone the lot from zone R2 (multiple dwelling) to zone C (commercial), to utilize the property for commercial purposes.

The property fronts Route 4, the main highway for travel between the southern villages and Hagatna. It is surrounded by commercial development and the change of zone will not be inconsistent with the present uses allowed in the surrounding area. A commercial use would allow the property owner to maximize the utilization of the property, thus yielding the government of Guam addition revenues from gross receipt taxes.

In addition, the establishment of a new business on Guam will further revamp the economy by creating jobs as well as provide more competition in the business arena, which will benefit consumers. Section 2. Lot No. 141-1-2-1, Municipality of Agat, containing an area of 683.46 square meters as shown on Land Management Drawing No. 040-3 FY83, is hereby rezoned from Multiple Dwelling Zone (R2) to Commercial Zone (C).

Section 3. Severability. *If* any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.
