AN ACT TO AMEND §17401, ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 17, TITLE 3 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO LEGISLATIVE SUBMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Purpose and Legislative Intent. The purpose of this legislation is to update the language of the existing law to accurately reflect the changes in the membership of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. The existing law reflects a requirement of fourteen (14) affirmative votes for legislative submissions. The fourteen (14) affirmative votes requirement was based on a legislative membership of twenty-one (21) Senators, which represented two-

1	thirds of the membership at that time. Since that time, the membership of I
2	Liheslatura has changed to fifteen (15) members. Hence, the number of
3	affirmative votes needed for legislative submissions is less than fourteen (14).
4	This amendment intends to make it easier to determine what number of
5	affirmative votes is necessary, regardless of future changes in I Liheslaturan
6	Guåhan membership.

Section 2. §17401 of Title 3 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended to read:

"§17401. Number of Legislative Votes Necessary for Legislature's Submission. No measure shall be submitted to the voters by I Liheslatura unless it shall have been adopted by majority of affirmative votes of all the members."
