

AN ACT TO AMEND §3108 OF CHAPTER 3; TO ADD A NEW §8416 TO CHAPTER 8; AND TO ADD A NEW ITEM (8) TO §3202 OF CHAPTER 3 ALL OF DIVISION 1, TITLE 19 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO SURNAMES OF MARRIED PERSONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. §3108 of Chapter 3, Division 1 of Title 19 Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:
- "§ 3108. Choices of Name Upon Marriage. Upon entering into a contract of marriage a woman may elect to retain her maiden name as her surname. Upon entering into a contract of marriage, either spouse may elect

to hyphenate his or her surname with the surname of the other spouse. 1 Intention of the exercise of said election shall be indicated upon the 2 marriage license application as provided for by §3202 of this Title." 3 A new §8416 is added to Chapter 8, Division 1 of Title 4 19 GCA to read: 5 "§ 8416. Name Restoration in Final Decree. At the request of a 6 party requesting his/her own name changed in a divorce proceeding, the 7 court shall, in the Final Decree of Divorce, restore that party to the surname 8 he or she had before marriage." 9 Section 3. A New Amendment. Item (8) is added to §3202 of 10 Chapter 3, Division 1 of Title 19 Guam Code Annotated and the existing 11 Item (8) in said Section is *renumbered* as Item (9) as follows: 12 "(8) Whether either party elects to hyphenate his or her surname with 13 the surname of the other party as provided for by §3108. 14 (9) Social security number of each party. If a party does not have a 15

social security number, he must state that fact."
