AN ACT TO AMEND §4110 AND TO ADD A NEW §4110.2 TO CHAPTER 4, TITLE 4 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO SABBATICAL LEAVE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM.

#### 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. §4110 of Chapter 4 of Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 "§ 4110. Sabbatical Leave.
- 5 All consultants, teachers, vice-principals, assistant principals and
- 6 principals of the Department of Education and academic employees of the
- Guam Community College, all of whom are permanent residents of Guam,

may be given a sabbatical leave of absence upon completion of seven (7) consecutive years of satisfactory teaching service. To be eligible for such sabbatical leave, an employee must have obtained a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent or otherwise be deemed sufficiently skilled and experienced to deserve such a leave. The Guam Education Policy Board, or the Guam Community College Board of Trustees, as the case may be, shall determine eligibility for such leave and shall schedule the same in such a way as to not unduly interfere with or disrupt the operations of the Department of Education, or the Guam Community College, respectively. As a condition for the granting of sabbatical leave, the employee must, during the period of such leave, be engaged in endeavors related to his field of employment, and agree to return to his employment following such leave for a period of not less than two (2) years. Sabbatical leave for the purposes of this Section, means twelve (12) calendar months of fully paid leave, and any accumulated regular annual leave must be included within and taken at the same time as the sabbatical leave."

**Section 2.** A new §4110.2 is hereby *added* to Chapter 4 of Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

#### **"§ 4110.2.** University of Guam - Sabbatical Leave.

Academic employees of the University of Guam, all of whom are permanent residents of Guam, may be given a sabbatical leave of absence upon completion of seven (7) consecutive years of satisfactory teaching service. To be eligible for such sabbatical leave, an employee must have obtained a graduate degree and tenure. Any accumulated regular annual leave must be included within and taken at the same time as the sabbatical leave. The University of Guam Board of Regents *shall* determine eligibility for such

- leave and *shall* schedule the same in such a way as to *not* unduly interfere
- with or disrupt the operations of the University of Guam."

#### **COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST**

#### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Public Libraries, and Technology convened the public hearing on March 4, 2010 at 9:00 am in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of **Bill 328-30** (**COR**) - An Act To Amend Section 4110 Of Chapter 4 Of Title 4 Of The Guam Code Annotated And To Add A New Section 4110.2 Of The Same, Relative To Sabbatical Leave At The University Of Guam. - By: **J.T. Won Pat, Ed.D. and T.R. Muna-Barnes** 

#### **Public Hearing Requirements**

Notices of the hearing were disseminated via facsimile and email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on <u>February 28, 2010 (5-day Notice)</u> and on <u>March 2, 2010 (48-Hour notice)</u> pursuant to meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notice of the hearing was also posted on the Guam Legislature's website.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES

Interim Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr. called the Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Libraries, and Technology to order at 9:07a.m.

Chairman Palacios: At this point, I would like to call up the only sign-up, Dr. Helen Whippy, from the University of Guam. Could you come up please? The author of the bill, the speaker, is not present. She is off-island at this time. However, the bill will be heard this morning and most likely there will be a mark-up meeting on this one more time upon return and we will share the testimony with her. (Gave an overview of the

bill) The amendment here is to create a new section dealing only with the University of Guam with the provision that the Board of Regent determines the scheduling for the taking of sabbatical leave and the determination of eligibility of UOG employees. I recognize at this time, Dr. Helen Whippy.

**Dr. Helen Whippy**: I am the Senior Vice President of academic and student affairs at the University of Guam. I am here on behalf of the UOG President who is off-island. UOG appreciates the legislature's recognition of its academic employees. UOG supports this bill with the following revisions on page 2, lines 20 to 21; that "satisfactory teaching service" be changed to "satisfactory academic service." The University respectfully requests that this revision be made to Bill 328-30 otherwise the University supports the bill as it is currently written.

Chairman Palacios: It appears that the new provision would be left up to the Board of Regent to determine eligibility and the scheduling of the taking of sabbatical leave. What led to that idea and to the desire to make that amendment?

**Dr. Helen Whippy:** In 1981, the original law, the GCA was put in place. In 1985, UOG was exempt from it. In 1998, there was another law that removed that exemption but the university didn't notice it so we had our own sabbatical leave policy since 1985. Instead of paying 100% of salary we pay 66% and use the other one third to help get placement for the person. It is much sounder fiscally rather than leave for an entire year. Last year, I noticed that we no longer had an exemption, we asked the board to approve revision to the 1981 one. Because of that I haven't been able to approve any sabbaticals because it would be fiscally irresponsible of me to do so. Go back to the way we were. We have our old policy which worked quite well for many years.

Chairman Palacios: Can that need be addressed by the Board of Regents?

**Dr. Helen Whippy:** It is currently in the legislation. It requires a 100% pay out of your salary for one year.

Chairman Palacios: So the Board of Regent cannot change that even if they want.

**Dr. Helen Whippy:** That is public law. So we are asking the senators to change that public law and take us out of the 100%.

**Chairman Palacios:** The Board of Regents, no member appeared here. What is your observation with respect to how they feel about this?

**Dr. Helen Whippy:** The Board of Regent is firmly in control of the governance of the university and they support this completely. In fact they requested it.

**Chairman Palacios:** It would be good if they submit some kind of testimony even a half page saying that they support this. It would be good to have that on record. If I were an academic employee at the UOG, if I were to evaluate this, I would say that this in some way would adversely affect my benefit.

**Dr. Helen Whippy:** We told the union at 100% we are not able to fund anyone. We have really strict rules. You must be a tenured professor. Our professors are too busy to take it.

**Chairman Palacios**: The policy would be to go to the Regent and convince the regent so the regent is empowered to debate those things. Please make sure that the committee receives some kind of endorsement from the Board of Regent. There is no other sign-up for this. Bill 328-30 (COR) is duly heard at this time.

Chairman Palacios concluded the hearing and requested that written testimony be submitted within the next ten (10) days. He adjourned the hearing at 9:20a.m.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4110 OF CHAPTER 4 OF TITLE 4 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 4110.2 OF THE SAME, RELATIVE TO SABBATICAL LEAVE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. §4110 of Chapter 4 Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 "§ 4110. Sabbatical Leave.
- principals of the Department of Education and academic employees of the University of Guam and of the Guam Community College, all of whom are permanent residents of Guam, may be given a sabbatical leave of absence upon completion of seven (7) consecutive years of satisfactory teaching service. To be eligible for such sabbatical leave, an

All consultants, teachers, vice-principals, assistant principals and

employee must have obtained a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent

or otherwise be deemed of sufficiently skilled and experienced to deserve such a leave. The Board of Education, or the Guam Community College Board of Trustees, or the Board of Regents, as the case may be, shall determine eligibility for such leave and shall schedule the same in such a way as not to unduly interfere with or disrupt the operations of the Department of Education or the Guam Community College, or the University of Guam, respectively. As a condition for the granting of sabbatical leave, the employee must, during the period of such leave, be engaged in endeavors related to his field of employment, and agree to return to his employment following such leave for a period of not less than two (2) years. Sabbatical leave for the purposes of this Section, means twelve (12) calendar months of fully paid leave, and any accumulated regular annual leave must be included within and taken at the same time as the sabbatical leave."

# Section 2. A new §4110.2 is hereby added to Chapter 4 of Title 4 Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

#### "§4110.2. University of Guam - Sabbatical Leave.

Academic employees of the University of Guam, all of whom are permanent residents of Guam, may be given a sabbatical leave of absence upon completion of seven (7) consecutive years of satisfactory teaching service. To be eligible for such sabbatical leave, an employee must have obtained a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent or otherwise be deemed sufficiently skilled and experienced to deserve

such a leave. Any accumulated regular annual leave must be included within and taken at the same time as the sabbatical leave. The University of Guam Board Of Regents shall determine eligibility for such leave and shall schedule the same in such a way as not to unduly interfere with or disrupt the operations of the University of Guam."
