I am the owner of Lot 1, Block 2, of the Subdivision of Lot 1098 remainder, located in the municipality of Barrigada, Guam, fronting Route 10. I am submitting this written testimony requesting the approval of the 30th Guam Legislature in the rezoning of my lot from residential (R-1) to Commercial (C). By rezoning my lot, it will give me greater opportunity to maximize the economic benefits of the property. Written Testimony by Mr. Tony Megofna Bill No. 306-30 Relative to Rezoning Lot 1, Block 2, from Residential to Commercial

I. Tony Megofna, to in support of Bill No. 306-30, the bill to rezone Lot 1, Block 2, of the Subdivision Lot 1098 Remainder, located in the municipality of Barrigada, Guam. I live nearby the aforementioned lot and I don't believe that the rezoning would cause any hardship or detriment to the surrounding neighborhood. I know Mr. Lujan and I trust that he will not permit any commercial activity other than a wholesome family business on his property.

I highly recommend that Mr. Lujan's request to rezone his property from residential to commercial be approved.

We are in receipt of your Letter, dated June 1, 2010, subject: Public Hearing for Bill Nos. 306-30, 324-30 and 391-30(COR). Our comments are as follows:

REFERENCE BILL 306-30

An Act Relative to Rezoning Lot 1, Block 2, of the subdivision of Lot 1098, remainder, located in the Municipality of Barrigada, Guam from Residential ("R-1") to Commercial ("C"); to allow for greater application and use of the property and surrounding area

21 GCA, Chapter 61, Section 61630(GCA), Zoning Law, requires that any rezoning must justify <u>Public Necessity</u>, <u>General Convenience</u>, and <u>Public Welfare</u>. In all zoning or rezoning actions, the Guam Land Use Commission upon making its findings that these have been met, may recommend to the Governor of Guam, approval of such changes. It is with these factors in mind that we present our position on the rezoning action.

Bill 306-30 provides an act relative to rezoning of Lot 1 Block 2, of the Subdivision of Lot 1098, Remainder, located in the Municipality of Barrigada, from "R-1" Residential to "C" Commercial to allow for all permitted commercial application and uses on the property. Our comments are as follows:

PUBLIC NECESSITY:

The development of the zoning districts and corresponding zoning designations for Barrigada, are predominantly residential uses. A few localized and select strip commercial zoning districts had been previously identified and made a part of the Barrigada zone map. The master planning for commercial areas has been very limited along major arterial roads which is deemed to be the highest and best use locations for such a zone; but instead, residential zoning was made the predominant zone.

Best planning practice would discourage residential uses along major routes since there is a heavy safety factor involve because of heavy and very high speed traffic moving in both travel directions.

Over the years Route 10 has undertaken a dramatic transformation in its physical aspects. It has been realigned and widen to what it is now; traffic has exponentially increase and vehicle speed has correspondingly increase. However, other road improvements have not been timely constructed such as sidewalks and bicycle paths that enhances the safety for pedestrians and cyclists alike; other road enhancement practices such as construction for side streets, cueing lanes or buffer strips were not considered and not planned that would support residential zoning along this major route.

Over the years, including the present time and with the pending military buildup; this fast pace, construction boom and population growth has certainly created a greater need for commercial uses which were not anticipated and not identified many years ago when our zoning law was formulated and eventually enacted.

Undoubtedly, there is an apparent need to address the surge of growth in every aspect of the neighborhood and the community as a whole; and thus, there is a need for upgrading and providing of professional and retail commercial facilities including storage and warehouse uses as well. These uses are basic common elements in order to meet the needs of both the residents in the area and the public at large. Professional and commercial activities and related accessory uses can only be realized if the proper zoning district is established. The location for such a zone makes sense and the outcome of such uses would support achievement of a positive economic growth not only for the Municipal District of Barrigada, but contribute to the island's total fiscal growth.

Therefore, we find that a <u>"Public Necessity"</u> is warranted in this particular rezoning action.

PUBLIC CONVENIENCE:

A positive aspect of re-zoning the property to "C" Zone is that it has the potential to bring benefits and services to everyone nearby or the traveling public at large. A new commercial establishment with additional and new commodities for sale can only provide greater convenience for everyone. The surrounding residents will be provided additional retail or other professional commercial services that are mostly found in nearby municipalities.

Although a new commercial activity may be considered as being competitive with other existing commercial activities; this competiveness, however, should be viewed in a positive manner since it can initiate the introduction of a variety of new products not offered by the other commercial establishments. Thus, a diversity of services and products could be brought in by a new commercial establishment which will benefit the immediate neighborhood as well as the general public; and in essence, is a convenience to everyone when such products or services are readily available.

GENERAL WELFARE:

The proposed rezoning of Lot 1 Block 2, (the Subdivision of Lot 1098 Remainder) would be compatible with current land uses. Nearby are several commercial activities in operation, such as a mini commercial plaza with a small store and Laundromat; two small convenience stores; a small engine sales and service shops with another adjacent Laundromat. There are scattered small pockets of "mom and pop" stores within the village. The location of the property to be rezoned and the designation as a commercial zone can only enhance and compliment other commercial activities; and hence, a new commercial activity would not be a novelty in the area, per se.

As in any higher density and intensity zoning consideration, infrastructure availability and capacity must be highly considered. We find that all of the major infrastructures exist and are considered more than adequate to support the "C" rezoning. The subject lot to be rezoned is fronting Route 10; and in turn, Route 10 contains within its right-of-way boundary, water, power, sewer, and telephone systems.

All of the required elements are in place. The use of such infrastructure systems by any commercial activities on the subject lot is not expected to negatively impact the existing infrastructure systems such that it will affect existing customers, future residents or the Barrigada Community's services and livihood.

The Guam Land Use Commission has consistently supported "C" zones along major arterial roadways. To illustrate this fact, the Commission had approved a recent rezoning from "R-1" to "C" on July 26, 2007 for Lot 1106-4-2. Since then, a sports store (Champion) is now in operations. This lot is now in the Municipality of Mangilao, but was formerly in Barrigada. The distance from the subject lot of the proposed rezoning to this Sports Outlet is approximately .5 miles. As can be discerned, a "C" zone is the preferred zone along major streets; and we expect this trend to continue.

"C" zones along major roadways are not only logical, but are the highest and best use in such strip areas. In terms of property value, it is expected that the value of the parcel will increase as well as property taxes. Property appraisal values for abutting and adjacent properties may increase as a result of this higher "C" zone, but it does not mean a corresponding property tax increase.

With the justifications provided above, we support the zone change of Lot 1 Block 2, (the Subdivision of Lot 1098 Remainder), from "R-1" Residential to "C" Commercial.

REFERENCE BILL 324-30

An Act to Authorize I Maga'Lahen Guåhan to exchange Government Property in Barrigada for Privately Owned Property located in Barrigada to be used for the Guam Flood Mitigation Plan

We point out that this exchange action has been ongoing since circa 1989 without final resolution. The specifics of the exchange has not changed since the action first began in 1989. In summary, the current action is for an "area for area" basis, exchanging an area of 11,322.54 square meters from Lot 2264-1-R3 for Lot 15, Block No. E. Tract 9 having an area of 7,144.54.

While this may appear contradictory in terms of the exchange area, it must be noted that the easement as is legally existing must be severed. It links with Pinate PL due northwest and continues along the rear lot lines of Lots 1 thru 13, Block 13. It is estimated that the easement encumbers an approximate area of 3,134+sm; thus reducing Lot 2264-1-R3 to approximately 8188 sm (11,322-3,134).

The major factor amongst other factors that should be noted and considered as being a fair land compensation is that the Government's acquisition of Lot 2264-1-R3 ensures the protection and general welfare of the immediate and surrounding residents as if affects their livability and livihood in residing in a flood prone area in an urban residential area. As is typical when establishing a subdivision, a "Ponding basin" would normally be required and particularly when it is obvious that there is an urgent need for it. This case is a classic case for the need of a "Ponding Basin."

Lastly, in the interest of the government, we need to ensure that the exchange as set out in the bill does not result in the government's commitment to any incurred cost.

REFERENCE BILL 391-30(COR)

An Act to amend §61619 and §61633 of Article 6, Chapter 61, Title 21 Guam Code Annotated relative to hearing date-notice

Historically, since the enactment of our Zoning Law circa in 1952, the "notice" requirements for a "zone variance" has not changed. The requirement for the erection of a "sign" for the purpose of public hearing notice was and has been limited to "conditional use" applications.

As has been the norm for zone variance applications, public notice has been via publication in a newspaper of general circulation and certified mail to individual property owners residing within 500' of the subject property wherein the propose zone variance is being contemplated.

Bill 391-30(COR) proposes a requirement to erect a "sign" on the subject property similar to that as currently required for a "conditional use" application. Our research on various US states vary from the typical public notice issuance via general newspaper publications and certified mail notices to landowners; to other states that additionally require a posting of such notice via "signage" on the subject property.

Our experience concerning the current notice requirements (without the sign notice) has been excellent, thus far. However, with this new signage requirement, it will enhance and expand the public notice requirement and hopefully, ensure that all affected landowners within the 500' foot radius of the property whereby the zone variance is proposed, will be aware of such action; and would allow them ample time for their participation in the zone variance process.

This signage requirement is not expected to be an additional burden on the developer or Applicant. We have seen favorable and immediate compliance by developers concerning the signage requirement for "conditional use" applications. Therefore, we do not anticipate a reluctance nor a major opposition to erect such signage notice. We support the amendment to §61619.

In Reference to Amendment of §61633

In regards to the proposed amendment to §61633, we see no differences in the proposed amendment and the language as is currently cited in the law. Therefore, we recommend that §61633 be removed from this Bill.




