#### **COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST**

#### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement, & Senior Citizens convened a public hearing on April 12, 2010 at 9:10am in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 338-30 (COR) - An act to amend §7120.3 to Chapter 7, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the inclusion of spouses, widows and widowers in the eligibility for issuance of special gold star license plates," sponsored by Senator Tina Muña-Barnes.

#### **Public Hearing Requirements**

Notices of the hearing were disseminated via facsimile and email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on April 1, 2010 (5-day Notice) and on April 7, 2010 (48-Hour notice) pursuant to meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notice of the hearing was also posted on the Guam Legislature's website.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr. called the Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement, and Senior Citizens to order at 9:10am, welcomed and introduced Senators present. Chairman Palacios then gave a brief presentation of the bill because the author was not present. He stated that Senator Tina Muña Barnes was one of the senators that left to Washington DC to present a resolution that was unanimously passed in the 30th Guam Legislature. In summary, there is already a law now that allows for the gold star issuance for Veterans for one of the license plates. This bill essentially would include spouses and widowers for those who have made the sacrifice in defending our country and to display the family's loyalty in serving the country. He then called those who are present to testify.

Mrs. Emily Leon Guerrero, widow of a fallen Guam Soldier, oral testimony, in support. Mrs. Leon Guerrero began her oral testimony by stating that she is a spouse of a fallen soldier, and that the reason she was present for this public hearing is that there is an existing law for the Veterans, but it also does not account for the sacrifices of the spouses and widowers. Spouses are here at the home front and there are soldiers out there who have paid the greatest sacrifice. She then indicated that this bill would be the greatest tribute to the spouses and widows to show honor and pride in our culture, as well as, to tell their children of the fallen soldier that their father or mother was a hero. In closing, she stated that this would mean a great deal to our children in order to remind them to be proud of their father who died for our freedom.

Mr. Abraham C Mora Jr., brother of a fallen Guam soldier, oral and written testimony, in support. Mr. Mora first stated that he is the older brother of Samson Mora who died in combat. As he looks around he sees everyone here alive and free, because of the many sacrifice that our men and women of the U.S. Armed Forces who volunteer to protect our freedom. His brother, Sam, died because he was there to help serve America's mission, and that he is here to support this bill. He then asks to amend §7120.3, Chapter 7, to include the original language of §1126, Title 10, USC, to include next of kin (children, brothers, sisters, half brothers and half sisters). According to the Department of Defense, Manual of Military Decorations & Awards, members of the immediate family will include a whole listing of people who can be claimed as next of kin. In closing, he stated that he wears a small gold pin on his lapel to honor his brother, and pointed out that there are not too many people who wear this pin nor do they know what the pin stands for, but if there is someone who has a gold star license plate, then they may understand why he wears a gold star. Please include everyone who is part of the family as part of the inclusion to this bill.

Chairman Palacios allowed Senators to give comments and/or questions.

Senator Tom Ada stated that he admires the strength shown today by Mrs. Leon Guerrero and Mr. Mora to discuss this issue and to do so in the manner that they did. He went on to say that he recognizes the points that they are making, this will be a difficult issue to resolve. Senator Ada believes that this is something that he will have to give special thought, because mothers and fathers have raised the fallen soldier. He indicated that he has never lost anyone and that this is not easy thing for him to consider, but he reiterated that he really admires their strength and for them to sit there and discuss this openly with us and the public.

Senator Telo Taitague stated that she shares the sentiments of Senator Ada in admiring your strength today. During session, Senators had a discussion with the mothers of the fallen soldiers. Senator Taitague then stated that she is a women's advocate and she would like to include your definition. She then asked, in the event that the star license plate was given at a cost, would you have any problems to endure these costs for the same amount even though other mothers would have this for free? Would you have a problem with this? In reading this

bill, it would have to include the "surviving spouses" as part of the definition. She then stated that she appreciates Mrs. Leon Guerrero and Mr. Mora coming down here today to present testimony in favor of this bill.

Mr. Mora stated that he would not have a problem paying for the license plate if he had the option.

**Mrs. Leon Guerrero** stated that she wouldn't mind if there is a cost for us, but this is why they are here to present that there should be no costs associated with receiving this benefit.

Senator Palacios asked where this would be a one time fee or not?

Mr. Mora stated that this would be a one time cost.

**Senator Aguon** interjected and stated if there is any special license plate, then there would be a fee for every renewal. In this case, we would have to include language to include and incorporate it into the statute.

Senator Tony Ada stated that he did not have any questions, but wanted to thank Mrs. Leon Guerrero and Mr. Mora for everything that they do for being there in support of her husband and his brother and for supporting the mission. Senator Ada then stated that he was a soldier too and his wife held the fort back home. Knowing that the fort was taken care of at home, he was able to focus on the mission. He then stated to Mr. Mora, that he knows that he serves in the Armed Forces, and thanked him for serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, and stated that without the soldiers and airman like Mr. Mora, we would not be able to enjoy the luxuries of our day.

Senator Frank Aguon, Jr. stated that he hopes that he is not segregating himself because he has a personalized plate or for the comment that he just made. With that being said, he thanks the panel for coming here today, however, he would not support the effort to charge for children, but perhaps for other family members. When you go through trying times, you would have to endure the spouses and children and giving this to them for free would be appropriate. When you look at the operation and the mission, we have had 14 or 15 who have made the ultimate sacrifice and to give them the recognition would be appropriate.

Senator Ben Pangelinan as the original sponsor indicated that it wasn't easy to decide on the definitions, and that they relied on was the Veteran community, it was their recommendation to include the definition. During that public hearing, the Veteran community and the various Veteran organizations came to him in order to restrict it to the original Gold Star License Plate initiative at the congressional level. This is what they wanted and we were confused because there are several definitions to this statute and we thought that it should be inclusive. The local

Veteran Affairs Office recommended leaving it for parents. He pointed out that the Gold Star License Plate programs in various U.S. States have incorporated very wide definitions while others have isolated this down to restrict it to only immediate family members, and that he pointed this out to the various Veteran organizations. Their recommendation was to keep it to the original definition of the congressional program. Senator Muña Barnes, who has a history of family relationships with people in the military, has decided to include the Department of Defense's definition and to make this more inclusive. If we do this, we would make it a little less special according to some Veteran organization. In closing, Senator Pangelinan stated that he wanted to make a little history to show that we were thinking also along the same lines, but this is what we have to look at ourselves and are we going to listen to the soldiers or their families.

Chairman Palacios concluded the hearing and requested that written testimony be submitted within the next ten (10) days. He adjourned the hearing at 9:35am.

#### III. WRITTEN TESTIMONIES

Mr. Abraham C. Mora, Jr., brother of SGT Samson A. Mora who was killed in Afghanistan on July 10, 2008, written testimony in support of the bill was received on April 12, 2010 via hand delivery. Mr. Mora's written testimony is appended to this report, please see attached.

#### IV. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement, & Senior Citizens finds that Bill 338-30 (COR) intends to allow spouses, widows and widowers issuance of the Gold Star License Plates by the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation and the Office of Veteran Affairs.

The Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement, & Senior Citizens hereby reports out Bill No. 338-30 (COR), as introduced, with the recommendation TO PASS.

Also, in DoD 1348.33-M, Manual of Military Decorations & Awards, C10.3.1.1. to read as follows:

"Members of the Immediate Family." Include wife, husband, mother, father, stepmother, stepfather, parent through adoption, foster parents who stand or stood in loco parentis, children, stepchildren, children through adoption, brothers, sisters, half brothers, and half sisters of a member of the Armed Forces of the United States.


