AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (g) TO §50103.1 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 50 OF TITLE 12, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO LOCAL SALE OF BONDS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

**Section 1.** A new Subsection (g) is hereby *added* to §50103.1 of Article 1, Chapter 50 of Title 12, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

"(g) GEDA *shall* undertake its best efforts to cause a portion of any bonds issued or sold by the Guam Economic Development Authority on behalf of the government of Guam or any entity of the government, to be offered for sale to residents of Guam, as well as to residents of other jurisdictions, *if* and to the extent that such offer and any sales resulting from

such offer *do not* increase the costs to the government of issuing and repaying such bonds.

GEDA *shall* announce such bond issue in the local media outlets and solicit interest from local financial institutions, investment companies, and investor representatives. GEDA *shall* accept pre-issuance subscription orders for such bonds *prior* to such bonds being offered to the non-local market. Upon the determination of market pricing of such bonds, GEDA *shall* notify the local purchaser who *shall* inform GEDA of a decision and commit to the purchase and execute all documents necessary to complete such purchase."



#### Juvenile center guard arrested for sexual abuse

SAIPAN - Federal agents arrested on Friday a Division of Youth Services jail guard on the charge of sexually abusing a juvenile at the Kagman detention center.

Tyron Farley Reyes Fitial, 24, was escorted by federal agents when he appeared in federal court before visiting Chief Judge William H. Alsup of the Northern District of California on Friday afternoon.

"Fitial is charged with violating a person's civil rights when he used his position of authority to force the person, a minor child, to engage in sexual acts while the minor was in the custody of the juvenile detention unit, located in Kagman on the island of Saipan," according to a statement from U.S. Attorney for the District of Guam and the CNMI Leonardo M. Rapadas.

A federal agent described the case as "horrible."

Fitial's arrest comes as part of a wider and ongoing investigation into abusive behavior by guards at the Kagman detention facility. the statement added.

#### **DPL** remits \$2.5 million to help out CUC

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (g) TO §50103.1 CHAPTER 50, ARTICLE 1, 12 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO LOCAL SALE OF BONDS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Subsection (g) is hereby added to §50103.1 Chapter 50, Article 1, 12 Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

"(g) GEDA *shall* undertake its best efforts to cause a portion of any bonds issued or sold by the Guam Economic Development Authority on behalf of the government of Guam or any entity of the government, to be offered for sale to residents of Guam, as well as to residents of other jurisdictions, *if* and to the extent that such offer and any sales resulting from such offer *do not* increase the costs to the government of issuing and repaying such bonds.

GEDA *shall* announce such bond issue in the local media outlets and solicit interest from local financial institutions, investments companies, and investor representatives. GEDA *shall* accept pre-issuance subscription orders for such bonds *prior* to such bonds being offered to the non-local market. Upon the determination of market pricing of such bonds, GEDA *shall* notify the local purchaser who *shall* inform GEDA of a decision and

commit to the purchase and execute all documents necessary to complete

2 such purchase."
